

As per the details, acting on information that three persons are helping terrorists and had provided them full help in forest areas, police raided suspected location and nabbed them. All three were taken to the police station for questioning. Apart from this, a day earlier, the police arrested three people from Nepal who were trying to flee abroad after helping terrorists. The operation is going on for last 18 days and so far nine Jawans including two JCOs were martyred.

As per the details, accident occurred around midnight on Wednesday. The members of police band were boarding a minibus from Akhnoor to Jammu after attending an event organised at residence of a Police Officer in Akhnoor. As soon as minibus reached Bateda on Jammu Poonch National Highway, it collided with a truck coming from opposite direction, causing injuries to 16 police personnel. Kanachak police rushed to the spot and with the help of passers-by, all injured police personnel were shifted to the hospital for treatment.


