

ACS inaugurates online registration portal for JK Medical Council

JAMMU: Additional Chief Secretary, Health and Medical Education (H&ME) Department, Vivek Bhargadwaj, on Thursday inaugurated Online Registration Portal of JK Medical Council, (www.jkmedicalcouncil.in), a body for registration of Doctors.

This is a major initiative launched by the H&ME Department under the guidance of Additional Chief Secretary (ACS) after taking over the charge of the Department. The whole process has been designed taking into account the Ease of Doing Business (EoDB), a major reform initiated by the J&K government headed by Lieutenant Governor, Manoj Sinha.

The portal will enable the applicants submit their application online, make online payment and get delivery of their provisional, permanent and additional certificates online. Besides, other documents such as No Objection Certificate, Good Standing Certificates, Duplicate Certificate, Verifications, CME registration can also be obtained online itself. Also, internal oper-

ations of the Council such as seeking verification, Registrar Approval and President's approval will also be done on the Portal with due process.

After reconstitution of JK Medical Council, committees have been constituted in the JK Medical Council including Academic Committee headed by Dr Mohammad Iqbal Sofi, Medical Superintendent, GMC Anantnag, Ethics cum Grievance Committee headed by Dr Chanderelekha and Disciplinary Committee headed by Dr Rajeshwar Sharma, Medical Superintendent, CD Hospital, Jammu.

The newly reconstituted council would be headed by Dr Saleem Ur Rehman, Director General, Health and Family Welfare, J&K and will comprise of Dr. Mohammad Iqbal Sofi, Medical Superintendent GMC Anantnag, Dr. Rajeshwar Sharma, Medical Superintendent CD Hospital Jammu and Dr. Chanderelekha, Former District Health Officer Jammu as its members. The Council will work both at Gandhi Nagar in Jammu and Benina in Srinagar.

Advisor Farooq reviews works on Tawi Barrage, River front view projects

Asks officers for completing twin projects within fixed timelines

JAMMU: Advisor to Lieutenant Governor, Farooq Khan, on Thursday asked the concerned officers to expedite pace of progress on Tawi Barrage Project and 'Tawi River Front Development Project' for completion within fixed timelines. Advisor issued these directions while chairing a meeting convened to review progress on these prestigious twin projects. The meeting was attended by Divisional Commissioner Jammu, Dr Raghav Langer; Project consultant JSCL besides Engineers of Irrigation and Flood Control, ERA and other concerned officers.

Advisor enquired about the reasons for delay in execution of these projects asking the concerned for sorting out the

issues hampering the progress on these vital works. Farooq Khan directed the I&FC department to invite the tenders at the earliest and execute the works to complete the project in 10 months time. Meanwhile, the Advisor also reviewed the Tawi River Front Development project which is to be executed under Jammu Smart City. The project consultants gave a detailed presentation informing that the Jammu Smart City Limited has prepared a Detailed Project Report to develop Tawi River front to give an aesthetic look to the River Tawi and to promote it as a major tourism attraction. The 7 KM long river front has been proposed to be completed in 2 phases. The first phase will start from 4th bridge to Main Tawi

Bridge and phase 2 from Main Tawi Bridge to Gujjar Nagar Bridge.

It was informed that Initially 2.7 km from Bhagwati Nagar

Barrage to Vikram Chowk Bridge will be taken up under the phase I. Besides, the meeting had threadbare discussion on various important issues

like construction of embankments/retaining walls, pier protection, raising heights of barrage and other components of the project.

Each SHG member will be given chance to showcase their products in batches on rotational basis throughout the year, the MD

revealed. On the occasion the MD was informed that the Haat is designed to provide hands on training to women in packaging, branding and marketing of their finished products. She was further informed that 75 SHG members promoted under JKRLM participated in this marketing fair so far registering cumulative business worth rupees four lakhs.

Dr Sehrish termed it highly encouraging at the beginning for these SHGs and said that it would act as a driving force for others set to display their enterprise in the days to come.
