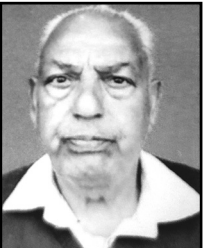

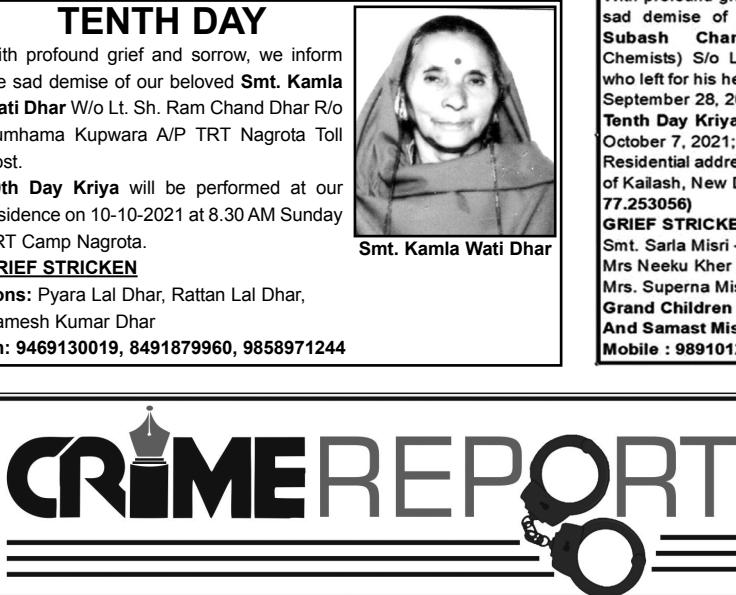

22 bovines rescued, two smugglers arrested

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday foiled two bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 22 bovines and arrested two smugglers.

As per the details, a naka was laid near Suketar by a team of Police Station Jhajjar Kotli where they rescued 18 bovines from an oil tanker (JK21/1281) which has also been seized. Similarly on another Naka at TCP Nagrota, a team of Police Station Nagrota also rescued 4 bovines from a vehicle (JK02C/1473).

In this regard, FIR No. 166/2021 under section 188 of IPC and 11 of PC Act was registered at Police Station Jhajjar Kotli and FIR No. 400/2021 under section 188 of IPC and 11 of PCA Act were registered at Police Station Nagrota respectively. The arrested accused were identified as Harpal Singh, son of Avatar Singh, resident of H.No.1384, Sec-7 Nanak Nagar Jammu, arrested by Jhajjar Kotli Police and Khalid Khan, son of Mohd Bashir, resident of Ramban, arrested by Nagrota Police. The recoveries have been made by SHO Jhajjar Kotli Insp Devinder Singh and SHO Nagrota Inspr Mohd Showkat under overall supervision of SDPO Nagrota Parupkar Singh.

Three inter-state narco smugglers arrested with 7 Kg Charas

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police achieved major success by recovering 7 Kg Charas from three drug peddlers in a vehicle (GJ19AM/9664) during Naka checking at Ban Toll Plaza.

As per details, on the basis of local intelligence generated by Jammu police, an input was generated. Acting swiftly on this, special police teams under the guidance of SSP Jammu Chandan Kohli, were constituted. An active Naka was laid by police teams of Police Station Nagrota under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Parupkar Singh, whereby dedicated police teams of Police Station Nagrota led by SHO Nagrota Insp Mohd Showkat rounded up three suspects who tried to flee away on being signaled to stop for checking. On search, 7 Kg Charas was recovered from the possession of three suspects, identified as Rakesh Pal, son of Bans Raj, resident of Bhabrekar Nagar, Greater Mumbai Maharashtra; Deepak Pandurang, son of Pandurang Narewade, resident of Indira Nagar, Pune and Bhailal Ramshiroman Pal, son of Ramshiroman Pal, resident of Surat, Gujarat. Trio was arrested and FIR No 399/2021 under sections 8/20/25/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Nagrota. The overall arrest and recovery was made under the supervision of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma.

Rs 40,100 fine recovered from SoPs violators

RAMBAN: Continuing the enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Tuesday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance.

The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 40,100 taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 57,43,600. The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance

besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC.

District Immunization Officer; Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 1581 persons were administered first and second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district on Tuesday. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1,654 samples including 345 RT-PCR and 1309 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 1,581 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

Notorious drug peddler arrested

BUDGAM: Continuing its efforts to curb the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Tuesday arrested a notorious drug peddler and recovered narcotic substance and cash Rs 50,000 from his possession.

As per the details, a party of Police Post Humhama at a checkpoint established at Hyderpora Chowk intercepted a Swift car (JK01N-5811) with a person onboard. He has been identified as Mukhtar Ahmad Wani, son of Ghulam Mohammad Wani, resident of Batahaar Narkara. On checking, 4 gram narcotic substance (apparently Brown Sugar) and 50,000 cash were recovered. He was arrested and shifted to Police Station where he remained in custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime has also been seized. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Budgam and investigation started.

4 burglars arrested; stolen property worth lakhs recovered

PULWAMA: Police on Tuesday arrested four burglars and recovered stolen property worth lakhs from their possession.

In a major breakthrough, Pulwama Police arrested four accused persons during the investigation of three theft cases (FIR No. 245/2021, FIR No. 275/2021 and FIR No. 276/2021) lodged at Police Station Pulwama. During the investigation of FIR No. 245/2021 and FIR No. 275/2021 three accused persons identified as Bashir Ahmad Sheikh, resident of Zafraan Colony, Fayaz Ahmad Sheikh, resident of Gund Darvesh Shopian and Ab Majeed Sheikh, resident of Bore Check Arihal were arrested. On their disclosure stolen property including 1 Golden necklace, 3 Golden chains, 7 Golden rings, 1 Golden pound, 3 pairs of Golden Bangles, 2 Golden ear rings and cash amounting to Rs 7.5 lakh were recovered from different places within and outside district.

Moreover, during the investigation of FIR No. 276/2021 another accused person identified as Umar Farooq Dar, resident of Sumbhal Rakh Asham Bandipora was arrested and on his disclosure 32 sheep were recovered. All the accused were shifted to Police Station where they remained in custody.

2 notorious drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing its efforts to curb menace of drugs from the society, Police on Tuesday arrested 2 notorious drug peddlers in Budgam and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

Officers from Police Post Soibagh at a checkpoint established at Farashgund Soibagh near petrol pump intercepted two persons identified as Arif Ahmed Bhat, son of Ghulam-din Bhat and Muzamil Ahmed Bhat, son of Mohammad Sultan Bhat, both residents of Wadwan Jagir Budgam. During checking, officers were able to recover 85 grams of Charas from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Budgam and investigation started.

Dhaba seized, owner arrested for violating COVID guidelines

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday seized a Dhaba at Bus Stand and arrested its owner for violating COVID guidelines.

As per the details, on October 5, 2021 a FIR No. 65/2021 under section 188 of IPC, 51 of DM Act was registered in Police Station Bus Stand Jammu, against one Mohd Abdullah Naikoo, son of Ghulam Ahmed Naikoo, resident of Logopora, Tehsil DH Pora, Kulgam, Kashmir at present Showket Muslim hotel, Near Platform, Bus-stand Jammu. The

accused was operating aforementioned Dhaba owned by him at about 3:00 AM, which is violation of DC Jammu's order of night curfew. The Dhaba was seized under section 188 of IPC, 51 of DM Act and FIR No 65/2021 under sections 188 of IPC, 51 of DM Act was registered against accused at Police Station Bus Stand Jammu.

Two chain snatchers arrested

KATHUA: Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Tuesday arrested two members of a chain snatching gang who allegedly used to target pedestrians and recovered stolen items viz one lady's purse, 1 Samsung phone along with Rs 1,000 cash from offenders.

As per details, on October 1, 2021 a case was registered at Police Station Kathua in connection with theft vide FIR No. 431/2021 under section 382 of IPC. Acting on the same, a party from Police Station Kathua led by SHO Kathua Insp. Om Parkash Chib under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Shammi Kumar arrested two suspects. During sustained questioning both of the accused confessed their involvement and on their disclosure one lady's purse, 1 Samsung Android Phone, along with cash amounting to Rs 1000 total worth approximately Rs 31,500 were recovered from the possession of two accused namely Kapil Kumar, son of Subash Chander, resident of Badala Kathua and Smil Dutt, son of Sardari Lal, resident of Chak Drab Khan Tehsil and District Kathua.

The accused not only used to snatch gold chains but also high-end smart-phones as people walk on street speaking over phone. Further investigation of the case is going on and their involvement in any other case cannot be ruled out.

Absconder nabbed after 11 years

He told that his wife is working in factory and took her daughter along from there she went missing. He has suspected kidnapping of his daughter. Police has registered a case and started investigation.

Jawan found hanging
