## SVAMITVA Yojna to be implemented nationwide to enhance rural economy's strength: Modi

BHOPAL: The SVAMITVA Yojna, a scheme towards the establishment of clear ownership of property, has enhanced the strength of the rural economy and it will write a new chapter of development of villages in the country, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Wednesday.

Addressing virtually a function in Harda district of Madhya Pradesh, Modi said after the successful implementation of the SVAMITVA Yojna on a pilot basis in some states, it will be implemented at the national level for ensuring the development of rural areas.

of Gram Swaraj in the country," he said.

The SVAMITVA (Survey of Villages and Mapping with Improved Technology in Village Areas) scheme was launched by the prime minister on April 24, 2020, as a central sector scheme to promote a socio-economically

empowered and self-reliant rural India.

The scheme aims at the establishment of clear ownership of property in rural areas by mapping land parcels using drone technology and providing records of rights' to eligible

SRINAGAR: Jammu and Kashmir Union Territory Administration on Wednesday stated that a pilot incentive scheme has been proposed to focus on increasing revenue and reduce power losses besides incentivizing the employees of the Power Development Department.

"Revenue Enhancement Scheme (RES) will focus on these issues", said Principal Secretary, PDD, J&K, Rohit Kansal at a meeting chaired by Union Secretary Power, Alok Kumar to review the progress of various power sector related works and issues in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir.

The meeting was also attended by Joint Secretary Power, GoI, Vishal Kapoor; ED, Power Finance Corporation, CMD NHPC Ltd, MD KPDCL, MD JPDCL, MD JKPDC, Executive Directors of NHPC Ltd & REC Ltd, Chief Engineers of Distribution, Projects and Transmission of JPDCL/KPDCL, and other concerned.

At the outset, Rohit Kansal gave a detailed presentation on the progress of the power sector in distribution, transmission and Hydro projects across J&K.
