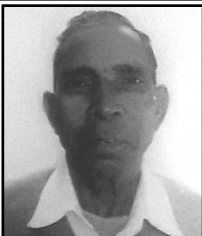

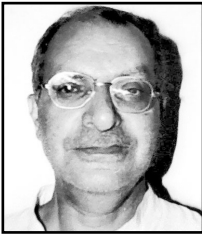

CRIMEREPORT

Two die as vehicle plunges into gorge in Reasi

REASI: Two persons were killed when their vehicle skidded off the road and plunged into a deep gorge in Reasi district on Wednesday, police said. The accident took place near Batla in Sawlakot when driver of a Sports Utility Vehicle (SUV) lost control over the vehicle while negotiating a blind curve, a police official said.

He said that rescuers swung into action immediately and after hectic efforts retrieved bodies of SUV driver Sourav Thakur (18), resident of Nagrota area in Jammu and Bachiter Singh (24), resident of Mahore. The bodies were handed over to families of the deceased for last rites after completion of legal formalities, the official said.

Drug peddler arrested along with 7 gm heroin

NEWSHERA: Police on Wednesday arrested a drug peddler and recovered 7 gm of hero-in from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Nowshera while patrolling in Rajal area found a person in suspicious condition, who on seeing police tried to escape but was apprehended. During enquiry, he was identified as Jasvinder Kumar alias Sonu, son of Karam Chand, resident of Lamberi Tehsil Nowshera and during frisking 7 gm heroin like substance and a digital weighing machine was recovered from his bag. He was arrested and FIR No 204/2021 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Nowshera.

Bootlegger nabbed with 450 bottles of illicit liquor

Two held with Charas

Major, JCO injured as Army's Casper falls into gorge

Transportation of illegally extracted minerals: 4 arrested, 4 tippers seized

BUDGAM: Police on Wednesday arrested four persons involved in transportation of illegally extracted minerals from Shali-Ganga Watrad Nallah, besides seizing four vehicles (tippers).

The vehicles used in the commission of crime were also seized. Accordingly, FIR number 228/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Khansahib and investigation started.

2 notorious drug peddlers arrested; contraband substance recovered

KULGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Wednesday arrested two notorious drug peddlers and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

Illicit timber recovered, 2 arrested

SSB constable, CRPF Jawan injured as rifles go off accidentally

Live mortar found, destroyed safely
