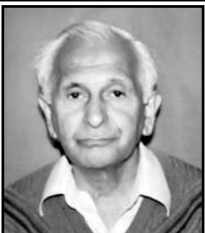

5 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police team of Police Stations Satwari, Arnia, Police Posts Phallain Mandal and Chinore acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles include a dumper bearing Chassis No NAE05259, seized by Police Station Satwari; a tractor trolley bearing Chassis No. MBNBBE-BAZMNB01823 seized by Arnia Police; a tractor-trolley without registration number seized by Phallain Mandal Police and two Dumpers (JK02CB 0264 and JK02CB 0260) seized by Chinore Police. The recoveries were made by SHO Satwari Inspr Sameer Jeelani, SHO Arnia Inspr Sumit Sharma, Incharge Police Post Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal and Incharge Police Post Chinore PSI Rajesh Kumar in their respective jurisdictions.

Missing minor girl traced, reunited with family

JAMMU: Police on Friday traced a missing minor girl and reunited her with family.

As per details, a complaint was registered at Police Post Talab Tillo regarding a minor girl who went missing from her house. Accordingly, FIR No. 113/22 under section 363 of IPC was registered at Police Station Nowabad and investigation got started. A team was formed under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Swati Sharma led by SHO Nowabad Inspr Vijay Kumar assisted by Incharge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Sonu Choudhary, which after putting in strenuous efforts, traced the missing girl. Subsequently, she was sent to CWC for counseling. Also, family of traced girl was informed and girl shall be handed over to family members after completing all the legal formalities.

Duplicate bags of JK Wall Putty seized

JAMMU: Police on Friday seized duplicate bags of JK Wall Putty on Friday.

As per details, a complaint was received by Police Station Gangval from JK cement its through authorized representative alleging that some person/firm were indulged in manufacturing, marketing, distributing, sticking, selling counterfeit of M/s JK cement Ltd brand.

On this, a team of Police Station Gangval under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Police Station Gangval Inspr Joginder Singh Chib raided at premised of one M/s Bombay Paints & Chemical Product, at Industrial Estate Gangval in presence of Executive Magistrate and recovered empty bags, 231 bags of wall putty and 18 marked with Jay Kay Wall putty. FIR No. 115/2022 under section 420, 483, 486 IPC 103, 104 Trademark Act was registered at Police Station Gangval and bags were seized. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SP South Mamta Sharma.

Warrant of drug-peddler booked under PIT NDPS case executed

JAMMU: Police on Friday executed warrant of one drug-peddler booked under PIT NDPS case.

As per details, information was received through reliable sources at Police Station Gandhi Nagar regarding a notorious drug peddler namely Ashwani Kumar alias Patti, son of Late Kamal Kumar, resident of Nanak Nagar, Jammu. On this, a team of Police Station Gandhi Nagar under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Gandhi Nagar Inspr Pankaj Sharma rushed to the spot and nabbed the drug peddler. In compliance to the directions by Divisional Commissioner Jammu under Prevention of Illicit Traffic of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act of 1988 (PITNDPS) detention warrant was executed and accused was shifted to Central Jail Kot Balwal Jammu after completion of all legal formalities.

Mother-son arrested with heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Friday arrested a mother-son duo and recovered 10 gm heroin from them at Marallian Morh Miran Sahib.

As per details, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib constituted under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh and led by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Zabeer Mushtaq rounded up two suspects on a motorcycle (JK02CU6405). During search, 10 gm heroin i.e., 6 gm from possession of woman (Pillion rider) and 4 gm heroin and a weighing machine was recovered from rider.

The accused identified as Rubina, wife of Mohd Musa and her son of Saleem, son of Mohd Musa, both residents of Kotli Mian Fateh were arrested and FIR No. 120/22 under sections 8/21/22/29/60 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Miran Sahib.

Notorious fraudster/land grabber booked under PSA

BUDGAM: Acting tough against habitual offenders, trespassers and land-grabbers, Police in Budgam has booked a notorious fraudster identified as Shoki, wife of Ghulam Rasool Dar alias Las Shikari, resident of Gangbuh Srinagar under Public Safety Act (PSA) for her unrelenting involvement in criminal/anti-social activities and deceiving/looting gullible people. During the course of investigation, it came to fore that accused was continuously deceiving, befooling and looting gullible people with her craftiness. Besides, she was also found involved in forcible trespassing the land of people on the pretext of land deals and has grabbed same through deceitful means.

Further investigation also revealed that the accused also used to attack the owners of said land/property with help of her associates and used to threaten common masses of her area to face dire consequences. The accused is wife of a land broker namely Ghulam Rasool Dar alias Las Shikari and both were acting in hand and glove for selling land/property on fake revenue documents. Her repeated behaviour of indulgence in offenses and activities created resentment among public. Accordingly, the accused woman was detained under PSA after obtaining sanctions from concerned authorities for her involvement in 7 cases of cheating already registered against her in districts Srinagar & Budgam.

3 drug-peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

JAMMU: AWANTIPORA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drug trafficking from its gross root level, Police on Friday arrested three drug peddlers in Awantipora and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

As per the details, a party led by Incharge Police Post Reshipora of under the supervision of SDPO Awantipora Mumtaz Ali Bhatti, during a Naka checking at Kavni crossing, intercepted 3 suspicious persons who tried to flee but were apprehended tactfully. During search, 16.1 Kg of grinded Cannabis powder was recovered from their possession. They were identified as Riyaz Ahmad Bhat, son of Mohammad Ismail Bhat, Javid Ahmad Bhat son of Late Gh Nabi Bhat both residents of Kavni Awantipora and Javid Ahmad Dar son of Mohammad Abdullah Dar resident of Dogripora Awantipora. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 213/2022 under relevant

sections of law was registered at Police Station Awantipora and further investigation initiated.

Udhampur double blast case: Some suspects detained, interrogated

JAMMU: Police and security agencies have started investigation in Udhampur double blast case and have taken some suspects into custody for interrogation them. Apart from this, police has also gathered information related to the incident by interrogating injured bus conductor and mini-bus driver admitted in the hospital. In case of explosion at bus stand, the police questioned the driver, cleaner of the bus. At the same time, on basis of the leads found in earlier cases in blast case, the police has raided some places in the district and detained some suspects for questioning. According to sources, close to half a dozen people were detained by police on the basis of suspicion, who are being interrogated.

Massive search operation launched after 'drone sighting' reported along IB at Kathua

JAMMU: Security forces launched a massive search operation in several forward areas along International Border (IB) in Kathua district following information about a suspected drone activity, officials said. However, nothing objectionable was found during the joint operation by police, CRPF, BSF and SOG on Friday, they said. The operation was launched after villagers near Talli hamlet in Marheen tehsil of Hiranagar sub-division informed that they spotted a drone flying along the IB late Thursday night, the officials said.

Two apple-laden trucks turn turtle, driver injured

KATHUA: Two trucks loaded with apples met with road accidents at two different places on National Highway in district Kathua, due to which a driver got seriously injured and was taken to GMC Kathua for treatment.

According to information, a truck (PB06E-9665) which was coming from Jammu side and going towards Pathankot, rolled into a side ditch on side of National Highway just opposite GMC Kathua, as driver lost control over the truck. Soon after receiving information, Hatli police rushed to the spot and with the help of locals, pulled driver out of truck and shifted him to GMC Kathua for treatment. The driver was identified as Manohar Kumar, son of Omprakash, resident of Ward No. 2 Tehsil, Bilawar, District Kathua. Similarly, in another accident, another truck (JK02AG-9217) near National Highway Barnoti falling under Rajbagh police station area, overturned in the middle of road after hitting the divider. On receiving information, police reached the spot and restored traffic movement on national highway. The truck driver suffered minor injuries.

Girl among four die under mysterious circumstances

JAMMU: Four people, including a girl, died under mysterious circumstances in different areas on Friday. As per details, Shalin Bhatt, son of Maharaja Krishan, resident of Sarawati Vihar, Bohri was found hanging in his room and was shifted to hospital where doctors declared him as brought dead.

Apart from this, body of Rajat Kumar, son of Janak Raj, resident of Puran Nagar was found lying in Panmihak area. Police rushed to the spot and took possession of body. A case has been registered in this regard.

Meanwhile, Priyanka Devi, daughter of Karan Singh, resident of Nud in Samba consumed some poisonous substance in her house. She was taken to the hospital for treatment but she died during treatment. Jai Prakash, son Biku Mattu, resident of Bihar died in a train accident in Bari Brahmana area. The police took body in custody and shifted it to hospital. A case has been registered in this regard.
