



**CRIME REPORT****4 vehicles seized for illegal mining****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which dedicated police team of Police Station Kahnachak and Police Post Chatha acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different location in their respective areas and seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles included 2 Tractor bearing Chassis Nos. QRT630605020494 and MBNAK49ADMTL51142 seized by Kahnachak Police and two tractor-trolleys (JK02CV-8778 and JK02AX-6235) seized by Chatha Police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Kahnachak Insp Rahul Mahajan and Incharge Police Post Chatha PSI Harjinder Paul Singh in their respective jurisdictions.

**Bootlegger nabbed, 30 bottles of illicit liquor recovered****STATE TIMES NEWS**

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday nabbed a bootlegger and recovered 30 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession. JAMMU: Acting tough against bovine smugglers and to curb bovine smuggling menace, Police on Tuesday rescued 15 bovines.


**2 arrested, 2 vehicles seized for illegal extraction and transportation of minerals****STATE TIMES NEWS**
