The Div Com visited Railway Station, Gorkha Nagar and took a round of the entire stretch along the Tawi Canal and inspected

It was informed that the work is in progress on Blue Green Project for Tawi canal from Gorkha Nagar to Railway Station at the cost of Rs 17.83 crore.

(Phase 1 and 2). It was informed that the project cost is Rs 20.17 crore.

It was informed that the project includes improved access to the park paved courts in Park area, construction of double storey parking for 29 vehicles, pedestrian bridges to connect left and right sides of the Canal banks, replacing old electric poles with new one, park lighting, water, ATMs and many other facilities.

The Div Com directed the executing agencies to expedite the pace of work keeping in view the quality parameters and complete the work within fixed timelines.



JAMMU: A two-day national level Continuous Medical Education (CME) programme having a theme of Combat Trauma Care: Emerging Trends will commence at Army command hospital in Udhampur district of Jammu and Kashmir on Saturday, a defence spokesman said. The command hospital, northern command, is organizing the two-day programme on October 15 and 16 at Dhruva auditorium, in order to deliberate upon the recent developments in the field of management of combat trauma, the spokesman said. He said the event will be attended by the top brass of the medical directorate of Army Medical Corps along with several eminent speakers from the civil as well as delegates from medical fraternity of all three services and senior officers from northern Command. The initiative will not only pave the way for learning of advanced medical protocols and patient management systems, but also give an excellent exposure to the medical staff of the Command Hospital, the spokesman said.

The command hospital, northern command, is a multi-specialty flagship hospital of the Army and plays a special role in management of trauma of all kinds especially those in the category of battle casualties and battle accidents. The spokesman said the event will also focus on enhancing the skills and knowledge of specialists and medical officers in the command hospital on the subject of combat trauma and its effective management since several new combat casualty care concepts have been introduced as a result of experiences from the recent war and conflicts, research on the subject and advent of newer concepts.


