Things like bamboo chairs and a table placed in the corner of your balcony allow you to sit and enjoy the outside view with a cup of tea every morning.

The most important thing to consider while working on beautifying your balcony garden is the drain and the slope of the balcony flooring. It must be towards the floor trap, or else waterlogging can occur.
