Court directs handing-over custody of smuggled cattle to SPCA Jammu

JAMMU: In a significant order of the Court of City Judge in CNR No JKJM030085642022 through Police Post Chimore, the accused and the owner of the cattle, Mohd Sharif, resident of Samroli Udhampur has been directed to pay Rs 265 per day per animal for feeding and maintenance cost of seized animals pending litigation. The accused was also directed to execute a bond of Rs 1 lakh each with one surety each within 3 days or forfeit the cattle to SPCA Jammu.

The increase in bovine smuggling has forced the government to adopt stringent measures to foil it. The establishment of 'The Society for Prevention of Cruelty To Animals, District Jammu' is one such welcome measure in the direction. SPCA Jammu is actively working for creating awareness and implementation of animal welfare legislations and penal consequences of their violation.

District Magistrate Avny Lavasa and Additional District Magistrate Rakesh Dubey Jammu are playing significant role in the implementation of animal welfare legislations including The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals 1960, the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Care and maintenance of case property animals) Rules 2017 and the Transport of Animals Rules of 1978. On 10/6/22, they have even revised and fixed the rates of cost of feed and maintenance of case property bovine animals seized by the police authority as Rs.265/day per seized animal. This cost is to be borne jointly and severally by the

accused and owner of the animals and vehicle in which they were illegally transported.

An app namely 'E-Sutra' has been developed by District Informatics Officer Sanjay Gupta which is a vision of Anshul Garg, who is at present working as the CEO of Mata Vaishno Devi. This online portal has not only simplified the procedure for general public, for obtaining certificate/ permission for transportation of bovine animals but is also a great step towards transparency and for ensuring a proper check on illegal smuggling of bovine animals. With the increase in registration of FIR in cases related to smuggling of bovine animals, the government has appointed Advocate Garima Gupta as a standing counsel for the SPCA (Society for Prevention of Cruelty To Animals) District Jammu and Sr Vice president SPCA Devinder Kaur Madaan authorised to file petition and applications in such cruelty cases.

According to rule 5(d) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Care and Maintenance of Case Property Animals) Rules 2017, if a FIR is registered for transportation and illegal smuggling of bovine animals with cruelty, then the vehicle cannot be released in favour of the owner of the vehicle but is required to be held as security. Moreover, as per Rule 8(2), the seized animal can be returned to accused/owner of the animal only if the accused is not found guilty of any charge. Till the pendency of the litigation, as per Rule 3, the animal is required to be

housed at an infirmary, pinjrapole, Gaushala, SPCA or Animal Welfare Organisation. Further rule 5 (1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Care and Maintenance of Case Property Animals) Rules 2017 provides that while handing over the custody of animals to an infirmary, pinjrapole, SPCA, Animal Welfare Organisation or Gaushala, the Court is required to determine an amount which is sufficient to cover all reasonable cost incurred and anticipated to be incurred for transport, maintenance and treatment of the animal. For this the Court is required to direct accused and the owner to execute a bond of the determined value with sureties within three days and if the accused and owner do not execute the bond, the animal is required to be forfeited to infirmary, pinjrapole, SPCA, Animal Welfare Organization or Gaushala.

Rule 5(2) further provides that the infirmary, pinjrapole, SPCA, Animal Welfare Organisation or Gaushala having the custody of the animal can draw on from the bond on a fortnightly basis the actual reasonable cost incurred in caring for the animal from the date it received custody till the date of final disposal of the animal. In such cases, permit of the offending vehicle is also liable to be cancelled under Rule 97 of the Transport of Animals (Amendment) Rules 2001, if the bovine animals are transported with cruelty, in unhealthy condition, without permit, in violation of Rule 96 and 98 of the Transport of Animals (Amendment) Rules 2001.

LIC of India introduces 'Dhan Varsha' plan

JAMMU: Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) introduced a new plan Dhan Varsha with effect from October 17, 2022 which is a non-linked, non-participating, individual, savings, single premium life Insurance plan which offers a combination of protection and savings.

"This plan provides financial support for the family in case of unfortunate death of the life assured during the policy term. It also provides guaranteed lumpsum amount on the date of maturity for the surviving life assured," LIC's official statement stated adding that the UIN for this plan is 512N349V01.

This is a close ended plan and shall be available for sale upto the end of current financial year i.e. 31st March,2023, it added.

The proposer has two options to choose "Sum Assured on Death" (1)1.25 times of Tabular Premium (2) 10 times of Tabular

Premium for the chosen Basic Sum Assured. The proposer can choose the term either for 10 years or 15 years. The minimum age at entry for 10 year term is 8 years and 3 years for 15 year policy term. The maximum age at entry varies from 35 to 60 years depending on the term and option of Sum Assured on Death chosen. The minimum Basic Sum Assured is Rs.125000/- and there is no limit for maximum Basic Sum Assured.

In case of age at entry of the Life Assured is less than 8 years, the risk under the policy will commence either 2 years from the date of commencement of policy or from the policy anniversary coin-

ciding with or immediately following the attainment of 8 years of age, whichever is earlier. For those aged 8 years or more, risk will commence immediately from the date of issuance of policy.

If the life assured is alive on the vesting date and if a request in writing for surrendering the policy has not been received by Corporation before such vesting date from the person entitled to the policy moneys, the policy shall automatically vest in the Life Assured on such vesting date.

Guaranteed Additions shall accrue at the end of each policy year, throughout the policy term. The Guaranteed Additions shall depend on the Option Chosen, Basic Sum

Assured and the policy term. The rates vary from 25 to 75 per 1000/- Basic Sum Assured.
