# Two UP labourers killed in grenade attack at Shopian; 2 suspects arrested

### **STATE TIMES NEWS**

SRINAGAR: Two labourers hailing from Uttar Pradesh were killed apparently in their sleep when terrorists lobbed a grenade at them on the intervening night of Monday and Tuesday in militancy-infested Shopian district of South Kashmir, officials said.

The incident took place at around 12.30 am on Tuesday when the victims identified as Monish Kumar and Ram Sagar, natives of UP's Kannauj district, were sleeping in a tin shed constructed as an out house, the officials said, adding the duo was working in the apple orchards as labourers.

The fresh attack came two days after terrorists shot dead Kashmiri pandit Puran Krishan Bhat outside his house at Gund village in the same district.

The labourers, who had come to the Kashmir valley two months ago, were rushed

The arrested terrorist was identified as Imran Bashir Ganie from Harmen, the additional DGP said, claiming that he has also confessed about his involvement.

Meanwhile, Kannauj Magistrate Shubhrant Kumar Shukla said the victims, natives of Danna Purwa village under the Thatia police station area, had gone to Kashmir two months ago and were working as labourers in Shopian.

Breakthrough achieved on under-construction

BANIHAL/JAMMU: The digging work was completed Tuesday on a 10.2 km tunnel connecting Sumbar and Dharam villages on the 111under-construction Banihal-Katra Railway link, an official said.

The breakthrough on T-48 Tunnel was executed by conducting a blast under the ofChief supervision Executive Officer of the Northern Railways S P Mahi, the official said.

It is a major milestone achieved on the Kashmir rail project and with this, the digging work on most of the tunnels in Ramban and Reasi district stand completed, a railway official said.

He said this is the fourth tunnel following the 12.6km

tunnel T-49 between Sumber and Arpinchala stations, the longest tunnel of Indian Railways, which was completed in January this year.

official Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Railway Link (USBRL) is a national project which is likely to be completed by next year.

Of the 272-km USBRL project, the work on 161 km  $\,$ was commissioned in phases. The first phase of 118-km Qazigund-Baramulla section commissioned in October 2009, followed by 18-km Banihal-Qazigund in June 2013 and the 25-km Udhampur-Katra in July 2014.

The work on the intervening stretch of 111
