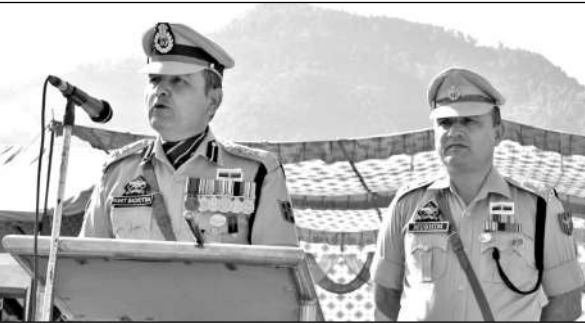


Police Commemoration Day observed

JAMMU: A meeting of the Inter-Media Publicity Coordination Committee (IMPCC) was organized on Friday by Press Information Bureau (PIB) , Jammu at Jammu.

The meeting was chaired by Additional Director General (ADG) (Region) PIB J&K and Ladakh, Rajinder Chaudhry.

He highlighted the working of PIB, Jammu and Kashmir and Central Bureau of Communication, J&K & Ladakh Region

Post Master General, J&K, Col. Vinod Kumar thanked PIB, DD and AIR for better coverage of their events in Jammu and Kashmir.

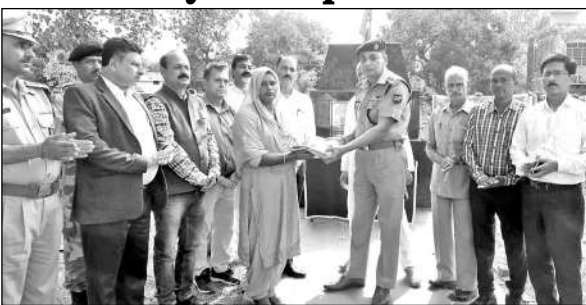
