

Div Com reviews Diwali arrangements across Jammu division

JAMMU: Divisional Commissioner Jammu Ramesh Kumar on Friday chaired a meeting of Deputy Commissioners and concerned officers to discuss and review the arrangements made by district administrations for the upcoming Diwali festival.

The meeting was attended by Commissioner JMC, Rahul Yadav; Director FCS&CA, Naseem Chowdhary; SSP Traffic Kaushal Sharma; Deputy Director Planning, Munish Dutta; besides Chief Engineers of PWD, JPDCL senior officers of Fire services, legal metrology, Police while Deputy Commissioners of Jammu division along with concerned officers attended the meeting through video conferencing.

The Div Com directed the Deputy Commissioners and concerned authorities to keep a strict vigil on sale and storage of fire crackers besides ensuring that the shopkeepers adhere to the guidelines laid down in this regard in all the districts.

He also asked DCs and Officers of different departments to put in all possible efforts for smooth celebration of Diwali festival by ensuring

availability of essential commodities, uninterrupted power and drinking water supply, medicare, security, sanitation and other services during the festival.

The Fire and Emergency Department was asked to ensure availability of fire tenders at the venue of sale of firecrackers, while Traffic authorities were asked to prepare comprehensive traffic regulation plans for smooth flow of traffic in the city, towns so that commuters do not face inconvenience.

Municipal authorities, ULBS, were directed to ensure cleanliness in and around the city during the festive season. Officers of FCS&CA, Legal metrology & Food safety were directed to keep a check on quality and rates of eatables besides conducting market inspections to avoid overcharging.

The Deputy Commissioners apprised the Div Com that all the arrangements have been finalized in the districts and necessary directions have been issued to concerned departments for ensuring smooth celebrations of Diwali festival in the district.

Meanwhile, the Divisional Commissioner chaired the Divisional Level Task Force meeting to review the safety measures for bridges on National Highway, PWD roads and removal of accumulated material.

Threadbare discussions were held on various important issues and identified bridges in the districts.

The Div Com directed District Mineral officers to find out the material availability under the bridges identified by NHAI, PWD. He also asked NHAI, executing agencies, to apply for disposal permissions for removal of material.

The Div Com instructed DCs to share the list of bridges identified so that necessary steps could be taken for the safety of the same.

The Meeting was attended by Chief Engineers of PWD and Irrigation & Flood Control, Joint Director, Geology and Mining Department and other concerned officers while Deputy Commissioners of Kathua, Samba, Jammu and Ramban along with DMOs participated in the meeting through video conferencing.

Public Notice

Solid Waste Management (SWM) Rule 2016 Notified by the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change, Government of India Vide notification No. G.S.R. 1357 (E) on 08/04/2016 mandated, **Bulk Waste Generator of Municipal Waste** to Carry out certain waste management functions by themselves.

1. The Municipal Committee Bishnah notwithstanding any other rules and provision, hereby directs, all **Bulk Waste Generators** who are generating **more than 100 Kg of waste per day** in total from the their identified premises/ property establishment to implement the provision of the SWM Rule 2016 and the Municipal bye laws thereof notified by the Municipal Committee Bishnah not later than 45 days from the date of this notice, including segregation into 3 (Three) categories/ Stream (Biodegradable/ Non-biodegradable and Domestic Hazardous waste) at Source, Storage within the premises for collection and undertake processing and treatment of biodegradable waste within the premises.

2. All RWAs, Market Association Members, Hotels and Restaurants etc. as defined will be classified as Bulk Generators unless they submit within the notice period a self-declaration of generating less than 100 Kg of waste from their premises.

3. Such Self-declaration will be subject to verification and penal cost (upto Rs 2500), if found untrue, Such self-declaration shall be submitted to the Municipal Committee Bishnah within 30 days of this notice for enabling verification. Self-declaration sent/submitted after the due date will be rejected.

4. Any violation of the SWM Rules 2016 for the bulk generation after 45 days of this notice will attract penal Charge/ fines as stated in the bylaws of the municipal Committee Bishnah. The Declaration if found false at a later date will attract penalties as per the by laws of the Urban Bodies.
