The said tours have been conducted as a detailed awareness cum sensitization camps in connection with the recently launched 'Jan Abhiyan' campaign which is a precursor to the much awaited Back to Village, Phase 4" programme of the government.

The local treks along tourist attractive areas like

Smart Sar(Lake), Kalhad, Saveri Marg, Dasoi, Nambal, Gabber, Bathnan, Gambri, Rich Bagla, Nangathub, Shiv Gufa Budhal of Budhal offBeat Destination and at Kotranka Kohri Hill, Kesari Hill, Patli Qila, Sankh, Dalyani, Marg, Dakhyar Peak were discussed in detail as these areas have immense Tourism potential.

Tourism Officers also educated the local community participants to maintain close relationship with the Government Departments for availing benefits of the schemes available with various Departments.
