



Thieves strike at 3 places overnight, decamp with cash

JAMMU: Thieves targeted three places in a night in Rehari area in which money and other items were stolen from a shop. According to information, Rajendra Gupta, owner of a shop in Rehari, found locks of his shop broken in morning and a sum of Rs 45,000 stolen. Apart from this, an attempt was made by thieves to target a medicine shop and temple in area also. After getting the information, police reached the spot and registered a case. Police said that thieves have been identified by CCTV footage. Apart from this, thieves also stole a car parked outside a house in Janipur area.

Woman dies; husband, children injured as car hits divider

JAMMU: A car collided with a divider in Nagrota area on Friday due to which a woman died, while her husband and children got injured. According to information, a family was going in a car and suddenly the driver lost control near Rajan Bar, due to which car collided with divider. Police reached the spot after getting information about accident and shifted the injured family to hospital for treatment, where doctors declared Ritu, wife of Mahesh Kumar, resident of Rohtak Haryana as brought dead. The remaining three members of family are undergoing treatment and were identified as Mahesh Kumar, Lakshya and Yash. Apart from this, Bal Ram, son of Bodh Raj, resident of Kathua in Govindgarh area of Kathua also died in an accident. He was going on his bicycle and got slipped. The accused was taken to hospital for treatment, but he died during treatment.

Excise Deptt destroys 2300 Kg Lahan

KATHUA: Efforts are on by Excise Department to curb illegally made liquor in the dis-

trict. As a part of campaign, Excise Department on Friday destroyed more than 2,300 Kg Lahan including 80 liters of illicit liquor during various raids in Excise Range Kathua. The Excise team destroyed illegal liquor distilleries by raiding Chak Drab Khan, Nihalpur, Kangreyal and Shteyal and other areas. In the process, more than 2300 Kg Lahan including 80 liters of illicit liquor, was recovered by raiding team and later destroyed on the spot.

Hit & run case solved; accused arrested

GANDERBAL: Police on Friday solved a hit and run case by arresting an accused involved in crime.

As per details, on September 26, 2022 an accident occurred at Derand, wherein a bike rider namely Manzoor Ahmad Kaloo, son of Ghulam Ahmad Kaloo, resident of Nesbal Sumbal got hit by an unknown vehicle, resulting in his on spot death. The driver of unknown vehicle fled from the spot along with the vehicle. Accordingly, FIR number 306/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Ganderbal and investigation initiated.

Acting swiftly, police party led by SI Fayaz Ahmad Incharge Police Post Nagbal started a hot pursuit of unknown driver and arrested him after hectic efforts. The accused was identified as Gh Hassan Kandro, son of Gh Mohd Kandro, resident of Ashai Bagh Nigeen, Srinagar. The vehicle bearing registration number JK01H-4211 was also seized. He was shifted to police station where he remained in custody. Further investigation of the case is in progress.

Fake Ghee' recovered at Anantnag

ANANTNAG: Acting on a tip off, Food Safety Officer (FSO) Anantnag along with DO Sher Bagh on Friday raided a premises at Nazuk Mohalla, Anantnag and found some culprits processing ghee like substance from fat spread and vegetable fat.

During the preliminary investigation, it was found that the same substance was being sold to general public as 'Ghee'. Meanwhile, FSO Anantnag has requested general public to purchase only properly labeled Ghee with relevant FSSAI certifications and stay away from counterfeit products.

Further, the department has taken up the matter with Police authorities for a detailed investigation in the matter to enable the Department to book all those who are involved in the illegal practice.

Rs 5 lakh penalty imposed on erring FBOs

ANANTNAG: Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC) Anantnag, Gulzar Ahmad Bhat, who is also designated as Adjudicating Officer under FSSA, 2006 today imposed a penalty of Rs 5,00,000 in 18 cases filed by Food Safety Officers of the district against various Food Business Operators (FBOs).

The penalty was imposed for violating different provisions of law including manufacturing/sale of substandard/misbranded food products and for non-compliance of orders of Food Safety Officers for not obtaining license/registration and violation of Schedule 4 of Food Safety & Standards Act, 2006 (Good hygienic & Good manufacturing practices). The ADC further directed the FBOs to strictly adhere to provisions of FSSA, 2006 and desist from unwarranted acts in future.

10 bovines rescued, truck seized

KATHUA: Tightening noose on bovine smuggling menace, a drive was launched by Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal, wherein 10 bovines were rescued and a vehicle (Truck) was seized near Maggar Khad area.

As per details, a police team led by Insp Vijay Kotwal SHO Lakhapur under supervision of DySP DAR Kathua Sukhdev Singh during special Naka/checking duty at Maggar Khad noticed a suspicious Truck (JK02W-0975) which was signaled to stop for checking. On seeing Naka party, driver of vehicle managed to flee leaving the vehicle. During checking, police rescued 10 bovines from the vehicle. FIR No. 91/2022 under section 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA was registered at Police Station Lakhapur and vehicle was seized.

6 vehicles seized for illegal mining

Drug-peddler arrested with heroin

The accused was arrested on the spot and FIR No. 206/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bari Brahmana.
