

**CRIME REPORT****Gang of car-lifters busted; 2 arrested, 5 stolen vehicles recovered****STATE TIMES NEWS**

BUDGAM: Police on Monday busted a gang of car-lifters by arresting 2 accused involved in the crime. 5 stolen vehicles with forged documents & registration numbers were also seized.

Acting on information, Police Station Chadoora busted a gang of car lifters and arrested 2 accused involved in sale and purchase of stolen vehicles. They were identified as Mohammad Youssuf Bhat, son of Abdul Rehman Bhat, resident of Karpura Charar-e-Sharief and Irshad Ahmad Sheikh, son of Abdul Raheem Sheikh, resident of Bugam Batapora, Chadoora. Preliminary investigations revealed that modus operandi of gang was to smuggle stolen vehicles from other states with fake and forged documents and selling the same to locals at cheaper rates.

Accordingly, FIR No. 135/2022 under relevant sections of the law was registered at Police Station Chadoora and investigation was started. During further course of investigation, several locations were raided by police and 5 stolen vehicles having forged registration numbers and documents were recovered, which include a Maruti Breeza, 2 Maruti Baleno and 2 Maruti Swift. Further investigation of the case is going on and involvement of some more persons is likely in case.

**4 vehicles seized for illegal mining in Ramban****STATE TIMES NEWS**

RAMBAN: District Mineral Officer (DMO), Kulwant Singh seized 4 vehicles used in illegal mining and transportation of raw material during raids in different areas of Ramban on Monday. On directions of the Deputy Commissioner, Ramban Mussarat Islam, the DMO, along with his team, conducted raids in different areas to check illegal mining, extraction, and transportation of raw material.

The DMO informed that during drive, 3 dumpers and 1 tipper used in illegal min-

ing and transportation of illegally extracted minor minerals were seized, out of which 2 Dumpers were handed over to SHO Chanderkote for legal action while Rs 38,785 was recovered as a fine from violators. The Department is taking strict actions against illegal mining, and we are trying to discourage it, the DMO added. The DMO advised consumers to purchase minerals from legal sources only and stay away from illegal miners. He warned that FIR will be lodged against violators, if found involved in illegal transportation of minerals 2nd time.

**Absconder arrested after 3 years****STATE TIMES NEWS**

UDHAMPUR: Police on Monday apprehended an absconder, who was evading arrest since last 3 years.

As per details, a team headed by Insp Pushpinder Singh under the supervision of Addl SP Udhampur Anwaar Ul Haq and Dr Bishnu Dubey SDPO Ramban raided suspected locations and arrested an absconder namely Munshi Ram, son of Titu Ram, resident of Dalsar, Ramban absconding since 2019 in FIR No. 78/2015 registered under sections 457/380 of IPC at Police Station Ramban. The absconder was arrested by a party of Police Station Udhampur. An arrest warrant under section 512 of CrPC was issued by Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Ramban against accused.


