## 10 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Stations R S Pura, Kanachak and Police Post Chatha acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 9 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicle included a dumper (JK028C-6136) seized by R S Pura police; three tractor-trolleys (JK02CH-1796, JK02CT-4431, JK02CW-0744) and a tipper without registration number seized by Chatha Police and two tractor-trolleys (JK02BD-1845 & JK02BG-9708) and two tractor trolleys bearing Chassis Nos KYBDH976076S3 and MEAA3119AM2339015 seized by Kahnachak Police. The recoveries were made by SHO R S Pura Insp Pawan Kumar, SHO Kanachak Insp Rahul Mahajan and Incharge Police Post Chatha PSI Harjinder Paul Singh in their respective jurisdictions.

Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP R C Kotwal also seized a Tractor along with trolley indulged in illegal transportation of construction material in jurisdictional area of Police Station Billawar.

## 3 mobile-snatchers arrested

BISHNAH: Police on Tuesday nabbed three mobile snatchers within 4 hours and recovered snatched mobiles from their possession.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Bishnah by one Nikhil Verma, son of Surinder Kumar, resident of Bishnah stating that his mother namely Anu Radha went to Bishnah market for shopping and when she reached Miran Sahib road near gas agency, 3 unknown bike-borne youth tried to snatch her gold-chain and mobile phone, but somehow she successfully saved her gold chain but snatchers flee with her Realme Mobile phone. In this regard FIR No. 174/2022 under sections 382 of IPC was registered at Police Station Bishnah and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Station Bishnah under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Police Station Bishnah Insp Vikram Sharma, after putting in hectic efforts, rounded up two suspects namely Abinash Kumar, son of Rattan Lal and Sunil Kumar, son of Swarn Lal, both residents of Suchetgarh, R S Pura. During questioning, both confessed their involvement in crime and on their disclosure snatched mobile phone was recovered. They also revealed identity of their associate namely Sameer Mattoo, son of Patras Mattoo, resident of Ward-4 R S Pura, who was also arrested. The vehicle used for commission of offence was also seized.

## Two narco smugglers nabbed, heroin recovered

KATRA: Police on Tuesday arrested two narco-smugglers and recovered heroin from their possession.

As per details, during routine checking, a party from Ballini Check Post signalled a car (JK20B 7551) to stop. On seeing police, driver and his associate started acting suspiciously and tried to flee, but acting swiftly the Police party tactfully overpowered them. On questioning, they disclosed their identity as Mandeep Kumar Bhullar, son of Joginder Singh, resident of village Mehmood Ka Mahal Ferozpur, Punjab and Rakesh Kumar, son of Lajan, resident of Sherbad, Katra. During checking, heroin weighing 12 gm was recovered from both of accused, who were arrested on the spot and a case under relevant sections of law was registered against them at Police station Katra.
