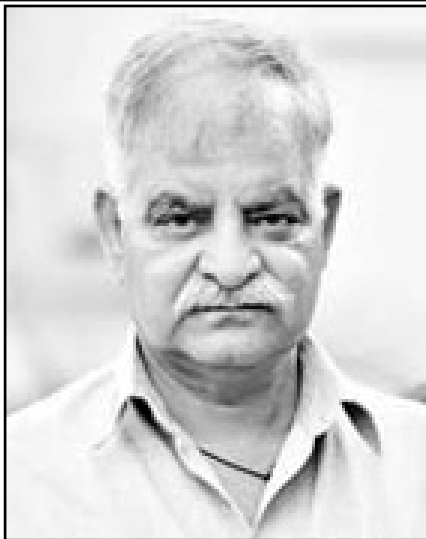

CRIME REPORT

2 arrested; 2 vehicles seized for illegal extraction, transportation of minerals

BUDGAM: Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police on Wednesday arrested 2 persons & seized 2 vehicles in Budgam.

As per details, a party from Police Post Soibugh at a checkpoint established at Soibugh Chowk intercepted 2 tippers bearing registration numbers JK04E-4899 and JK04E-8398 loaded with soil, illegally extracted from Government land at Garend Kalan. Both vehicles were seized and drivers, identified as Mushtaq Ahad Dar; son of Abdul Ahad Dar and Mukhtar Ahmad Ganie, son of Mohammad Akbar Ganie, both residents of Shahpora, Chatabugh were arrested. Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered at police station Budgam and further investigation started.

Drug-peddler arrested, contraband recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from society, Police on Wednesday arrested a drug-peddler and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Beerwah at a checkpoint established at Chewdara crossing near DIET Beerwah intercepted a vehicle (Hyundai Santro car) bearing registration number JK01F-2247 driven by one Kousar Ali Mir; son of Mohd Abdullah Mir, resident of Wanihama, Beerwah. During checking, police party recovered 17.6 Kg poppy straw concealed in 4 nylon bags from his possession. He was arrested and the vehicle used in the commission of crime was also seized. Accordingly, FIR number 143/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Beerwah and investigation started.

Thief arrested; 5 stolen two-wheelers, other items recovered

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday solved a theft case by arresting an accused besides recovering two scooters, three bicycles and other stolen items from him.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Miran Sahib by one Rakesh Kumar, son of Bihari Lal, resident of Kotli Miyan Fateh regarding theft of a Water Pump Motor, Fan motors and some copper wire from his shop situated at Kotli Miyan Fateh. Accordingly, FIR No. 121/2022 under sections 454/380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Miran Sahib and investigation started. After

this, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib led by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq under supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh, after putting in strenuous efforts and with help of CCTV footages of the area, rounded up a suspect namely Vishal Singh, son of Romesh Lal, resident of Chatha Mill. During sustained

questioning accused confessed his involvement in crime and on his disclosure, stolen items were recovered. The recovered items include grey coloured Activa scooter bearing Chassis number JF50E-80680835; Red coloured Activa scooter bearing Chassis number JC44E-0335183; three bicycles; one water pump motor; two fan motors along with some copper wires.

Hit & run case solved; accused arrested

JAMMU: Police on Wednesday solved a hit and run case by arresting an accused. As per details, information was received at Police Station Kahnachak through reliable sources regarding an accident between a car and motorcycle (JK02CS 9518) driven by one Ashok Kumar, son of Bato Ram, due to which bike-rider Ashok Kumar and his wife (pillion-rider) Asha Devi got injured and later Asha Devi succumbed to injuries during treatment in hospital. In this regard, FIR No.122/2022 under sections 279/337 of IPC and an offence under section 304-A IPC was registered at Police Station Kahnachak and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Kahnachak under the supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Kahnachak Inspr Rahul Mahajan, after putting in strenuous efforts, arrested accused driver (JK02CT 0608) namely Bownkesh Razdan, son of D Razdan, resident of Lane-1, Paragti Nagar, Upper Barnai Jammu.

5 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Station Bishnah, Police Posts Gujjar Nagar and Phallain Mandal acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 5 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The recoveries were made by SHO Bishnah Inspr Vikram Sharma, Incharge Police Posts Gujjar Nagar PSI Ajaz Ahmed and Phallain Mandal-PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal in their respective jurisdictions.



Transgender assaulted, chain snatched

At the same time, from the house of Ashok Kumar, who lives in Fattu Chogan, thieves decamped with cash and jewellery.

Youth killed over dispute; family demands justice
