JAMMU: All J&K Low Paid Government Employees Federation (AJKLPGEF) has urged the UT administration to release of 4 per cent DA installment pending w.e.f., July 1, 2022 in favour of all J&K employees and pensioners, as the same has been released by the Union Government.

In a press statement issued on Thursday, President AJKLPGEF, Jagdish Raj Sharma also requested the administration for issuing necessary instructions to enhance Medical Allowance from present paltry amount Rs 300 to at least Rs 1000 per month, as paid to Central Government employees.

He also highlighted demands of daily-wagers including implementation of minimum daily-wages, releasing pending wages, regularizing their services etc. Jagdish also urged for restoring the old pension scheme in place of New Pension Scheme. Others demands highlighted on the occasion included extension of leave encashment benefit to teachers, re-organisation of clerical cadre and removal of pay anomalies, immediate regularization of all those Adhoc, contractual employees who have completed seven years of service.
