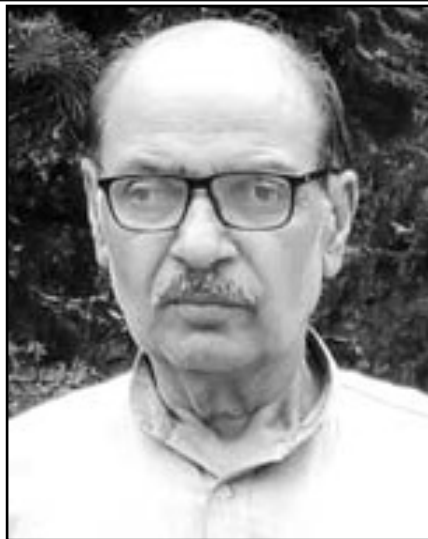

CRIME REPORT

14 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a massive crackdown on the menace of illegal mining 14 vehicles involved got seized on second consecutive day.

As per the details, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Stations Arnia, Kanachak, R S Pura, Police Posts Phallian Mandal, Sidhra, Chatha and Border Police Post Chakrohi acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 14 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles included a JCB bearing Registration No. HP17A-7463, a Tractor-Trolley bearing Chassis No H8035051716059810N, a tractor-trolley bearing Registration No. JK21B-7490 and two tractor trolleys without Registration numbers seized by Arnia Police; a Tractor-Trolley bearing Chassis No.EZIDU507305S3 seized by Kanachak Police; a Tractor bearing chassis No MBNBEBBELKNK04133 and a Tipper bearing Registration No JK02CR9378 seized by R S Pura Police; a Tractor-Trolley bearing chassis No. WZCB51929950747 seized by Phallain Mandal Police; a Tractor bearing Registration No JK02CJ-3130 seized by Sidhra Police and Three Tractor-Trolleys bearing Registration No JK02BX-6296, Chassis No.MBNGAANU-UMJ0C03073 and Chassis no. MBNAU48AFLCA47152 seized by Chatha Police and a Tractor Trolley bearing Chassis No EPN3040000860CM seized by Chakrohi Police. The recoveries were made by SHO Arnia Insnr Sumit Sharma, SHO Kanachak Insnr Rahul Mahajan, SHO R S Pura Insnr Pawan Kumar, Incharge Police Posts Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal, Sidhra SI Majid Hussain, Chatha PSI Harjinder Paul Singh and Chakrohi PSI Ishfaq Ahmed Kasana in their respective jurisdictions.

Absconder nabbed

JAMMU: Police on Saturday nabbed an absconder who was evading his arrest for 10 months.

As per details, an information was received at Police Post Gujjar Nagar through reliable sources regarding an absconder who was evading his arrest since 10 months in FIR No. 03/2022 under sections 341/323/382 IPC of Police Station Peer Mitha.

On this, a team of Police Station Peer Mitha under the supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kallu led by SHO Peer Mitha Insnr Mohd Rashid assisted by Incharge Police Post Gujjar Nagar PSI Ajaz Ahmed, after putting in strenuous efforts, raided at Maari district Reasi and arrested the accused namely Balbir Singh, son of Vijay Ram, resident of Maari Reasi. It is pertinent to mention that a stolen Alto car (JK02CA-3441) was also recovered from his possession.

Two missing persons traced; reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Saturday traced two missing persons and reunited them with their families.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Kahnachak by legal heirs of a boy stating that went missing from his house. In this regard, a missing report was registered on October 7, 2022 and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Kahnachak under the supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Kahnachak Insnr Rahul Mahajan, after putting in strenuous efforts, traced the missing boy.

Similarly another complaint was lodged at Police Station R S Pura regarding missing of a woman by her legal heirs stating that she went missing from her house after which a missing report was registered on September 21 and investigation started. A team of Police Station R S Pura under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO RS Pura Insnr Pawan Kumar assisted by Incharge Border Police Post Chakroi PSI Ishfaq Kasana, after putting in strenuous efforts, traced the missing woman. Subsequently, families of both missing persons were informed and they were reunited with

their families after completing all legal formalities.

Two kidnapping cases solved; girl, minor child recovered

JAMMU: Police on Saturday solved two different kidnapping cases by rescuing a girl and a minor boy.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Satwari by father of a girl stating that one Sunil Kumar, son of Ram Prashad, resident of Nepal, at present Gangyal, Jammu has kidnapped her daughter when she had gone to Agriculture University Chatha. FIR No. 166/2022 under section 366 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Satwari under supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Satwari Insnr Sameer Jeelani assisted by Incharge Police Post Chatha PSI Harjinder Pal Singh after putting in strenuous efforts, generated input regarding presence of accused person in Delhi. On this, a special police team was sent to Delhi and with help of local police kidnapped girl was recovered.

Similarly another complaint was lodged at Police Station Bahu Fort by legal heirs of a one and half year old minor girl stating that she was kidnapped by someone. On this, FIR No 252/2022 under section 363 of IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, team of Police Station Bahu Fort under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari led by SHO Bahu Fort Insnr Nayat Ali, after putting in strenuous efforts, generated input that minor child has been taken to Punjab. On this, a team was sent to Punjab and with help of local police, minor girl child was recovered from railway station Jalandhar, Punjab. Subsequently, both the traced girls were handed over to their families after completing all legal formalities.

Theft case solved; accused arrested, stolen gold & silver ornaments recovered

JAMMU: Police on Saturday a theft case by arresting an accused and recovered stolen gold and silver ornaments from his possession.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Chinore by one Balvinder Singh stating that some unknown persons stole gold and silver ornaments from his house situated at Kamal Nagar, Bantalab. In this regard, FIR No. 340/2022 under section 457/380 IPC was registered at Police Station Domana and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Chinore under the supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Domana Insnr Tilak Raj assisted by Incharge Police Post Chinore PSI Rajesh Kumar, after putting in strenuous efforts and connecting various leads, finally rounded up a suspect namely Shiv Bhat, son of Roshan Lal Bhat, resident of Kamal Nagar, Bantalab Jammu. During sustained questioning, accused confessed his crime and on disclosure all the stolen items were recovered.



Two narco-smugglers nabbed with heroin, sharp-edged weapon, poppy straw

JAMMU: Continuing drive against drug abuse, Police on Saturday arrested two drug-peddlers under the jurisdictions of Miran Sahib & Pounichak and recovered 4.5 Kg heroin, a sharp-edged weapon and 5 Kg poppy straw from them.

As per details, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib constituted under the supervision of SDPO RS Pura Surinder Singh and led by SHO Miran Sahib Insnr Zaheer Mushtaq assisted by PSI Mohd Altaf while on Naka duty at Kotli Mian Fateh area rounded up a suspect and recovered 4.5 gm heroin and a sharp-edged weapon from

him. The accused identified as Sahil Choudhry, son of Karnail Singh, resident of Chak Alawul Tehsil RS Pura was arrested and FIR No. 127/2022 under section 8/21/22 /60 of NDPS Act and 4/25 of Arms Act was registered against him at Police Station Miran Sahib.

Similarly another team of Police Post Pounichak constituted under supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh and led by SHO Domana Insnr Tilak Raj assisted by Incharge Police Post Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria while on Naka duty rounded up an accused namely Rajinder Singh, son of Mohan Singh, resident of Tirlokpur, Jammu. During search, 5 Kg Poppy straw was recovered from his possession. In this regard, a case under relevant sections was registered at Police Station Domana and accused was arrested.

5 drug-peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Saturday arrested 5 drug peddlers in Budgam & Awantipora. Contraband substances were also recovered from their possession.

In Budgam, a party of Police Station Khag at a checkpoint established near Block Office Khag intercepted a suspect and during search, recovered 24 gm Charas from his possession. The accused, identified as Zahoor Ahmad Bhat, son of Abdul Raheem Bhat, resident of Takibal Breewah, was arrested and FIR No. 58/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Khag and investigation started.

During the course of investigation, the accused admitted that he had purchased contraband substance from one Ghulam Mohammad Naik @ Bringi, son of Abdul Gani Naik and his son namely Parveez Ahmad Naik, resident of Sutharan Khag. He also narrated that more Charas like substance is lying in their house for sale purpose. Subsequently, a party along with Executive Magistrate 1st Class Khag raided the house and recovered 15 Kg Cannabis leaves however, father-son duo managed to escape from spot while efforts are on to effect their arrest. Further investigation into the matter is going on and more arrests and recoveries are expected.

Similarly in Awantipora, a party from Police Station Pampore at a checkpoint established on Befina road intercepted a vehicle (Maruti 800) bearing registration number JK13E-5230 with four person onboard, who were identified as Muneer Rasool Bhat @ Gopa son of Gh Rasool Bhat, resident of Namblabal, Adil Ali, son of Ali Mohd Dar, resident of Samboora, Javid Ahmad Dar @ Trecha, son of Mohd Akram Dar, resident of Meep Pampore and Naseer Ahmad Shah, son of Bashir Ahmad Shah, resident of Chandhara Pampore. During search, 6.5 Kg Poppy Straw was recovered from their possession. They were arrested and vehicle used in crime was also seized. Accordingly, FIR No. 123/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Pampore and investigation started.

2 arrested, 2 vehicles seized for illegal extraction & transportation of minerals

AWANTIPORA: Acting tough against elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police on Saturday arrested 2 persons & seized 2 vehicles in Awantipora.

Police Station Awantipora received information about illegal extraction and transportation of minerals at Jawbara area of Awantipora. Accordingly, a party from Police Station Awantipora under the supervision of SHO Awantipora raided the specific location and seized 2 Tipplers bearing registration numbers JK01AK-7747 and JK01P-2316, loaded with illegally extracted sand. The drivers of the vehicles were also arrested, who were later identified as Mudsir Ahmad Reashi, son of Ab Rahim, resident of Lethpora Awantipora and Aijaz Ahmad Khan, son of Abdul Rashid Khan, resident of Jawbara Awantipora.

Accordingly, FIR No. 223/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Awantipora and further investigation started.
