

Pace of development works unprecedented in J&K under Modi's regime: Col Mahan

Basohli: The pace of development works being carried out in Jammu and Kashmir is unprecedented under Prime Minister Narendra Modi led government as earlier it took years to even start the projects. He said that unlike others, the BJP government at the Centre has not only focused on starting new projects but also arranged adequate funds to complete these projects on time.

This was stated by Col Mahan Singh (Retd.) DDC Chairman Kathua while starting several development projects under CAPEX Plan for FY 2022-23 in Basohli region amid chanting of slogan like "Bhartiya Janata Party Zindabad", "PM Modi Zindabad" by jubilant villagers. Another project worth Rs 5 lakh was inaugurated to improve connectivity for Braham Kumar Ashram in Plahi Panchayat. DDC Chairman was accompanied by Sushma Jamwal Chairperson Basohli, Ram Chand (Ex BDO),

Darshan Choudhary, Ajet Singh Naib Sarpanch, Capt Des Raj, Nek Ram, Kishori Lal and others. Large number of prominent persons and local residents including women and youth were present. RDD officials were also present.

Speaking to media persons, the DDC Chairman appreciated Modi Government's vision for rural India, adding that UT administration and
