CRIME REPORT

Kishtwar police arrests notorious drug peddler

KISHTWAR: Kishtwar Police on Saturday arrested a drug peddler from the Malipath area and recovered from him a cannabis-like substance from his possession.

A special team led by SHO PS Kishtwar, Insp Parvaiz Ahmed Khanday assisted by SI Lal Hussain under the supervision of Dy SP Hqrs Kishtwar Dr Ishan Gupta set up a check point at the Malipath area.

During thorough check of vehicle and pedestrian, the police noticed suspicious behavior of an individual attempting to evade the checkpoint. The police swiftly apprehended him. Upon inspection, the police discovered a cannabis-like substance in his possession and took him into custody.

The arrested drug peddler identified as Muzaffer Hussain, R/o Om Mehta Road, Kishtwar.

In this connection a case FIR No. 236/2023 under Sec. 8/20 NDPS Act has been registered at P/S Kishtwar, and an investigation is underway.

Reasi police nabbed 4 drug peddlers

In another incident, Police apprehended two persons namely Kaku Ram and Munna both R/O Serwad Katra at Searly Naka during checking/frisking and recovered 23 strips of Tramadol Capsules and 20 strips of alprazolam 0.5 gm from their possession.

On this, case FIR No. 303/2023 U/S 8/21/22 NDPS Act registered at Police Station Katra and investigation initiated to unearth the forward and backward linkages.

The whole operation is led by SHO Reasi Insp. Vijay Sharma and SHO Katra Insp. Nishant Gupta under the supervision of Dy.SP headquarter Neeraj Padyar and SDPO Katra Surinder Singh.

Owner charred to death as fire turns furniture factory into ashes

AKHNOOR: A factory owner was charred to death when a major fire engulfed the furniture and mattresses manufacturing unit on Saturday morning in Akhnoor area. Police said that furniture factory named "Nandini" was engulfed in a wild inferno this morning in village Gandharwan of Akhnoor.

"Goods worth lakhs including furniture and coir mattresses destroyed in the fire while factory owner identified as Rajinder Singh was charred to death," police added.

They said that fire tenders were immediately pressed into service to douse the flames and the fire was prevented from spreading to nearby locations.

"Initially, short circuit is the cause of fire but we have registered a case and started the investigation," police added.

Cop held for killing brother over land dispute in Doda

DODA: A special police officer (SPO) on Saturday killed his elder brother over land dispute in Gandoh area of Doda district, said officials.

The deceased was identified as Ishtiyaz Ahmad, 56, a teacher by profession.

Doda district SSP Abdul Qayoom said, "SPO Intiyaz Ahmad, aged around 38 years, had some dispute over ancestral land with his real elder brother Ishtiyaz Ahmad, a teacher. This morning the former had some arguments with the latter over cutting grass and in a fit of rage attacked the latter on his head with a stick causing him grievous injuries."

The victim died on his way to a hospital in Doda district.

Gandoh SHO inspector Vikram Singh said, "We have arrested the accused SPO. The FIR has now been converted into Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code from Section 307."
