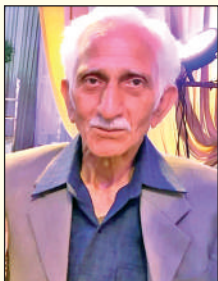

Father-son injured in attack by wild bear

The locals rushed to the spot and saved them, officials said, adding that they were shifted to a hospital for treatment.

Suspicious object detected, destroyed in Kupwara

SRINAGAR: Security forces on Friday detected and later destroyed a suspicious object in Jammu and Kashmir's Kupwara district, officials said.

A road opening party of the Army detected two suspicious small gas cylinders, suspected to be IEDs, on the roadside at Odipora in the Kralgund area of the north Kashmir district, the officials said.

A bomb disposal squad was called to the spot which later destroyed the suspicious object, they said.

There was no loss of life or damage to property during the destruction of the suspicious object, they added.

Swift action against encroachment: Illegally constructed structure demolished

5 hardened criminals involved in attempt to murder & rape arrested

SAMBA: Police on Friday arrested five hardened criminals involved in attempt to murder, extortion, kidnapping & rape in the jurisdiction of PS Vijaypur, PS Samba and PS Bari Brahmana.

The arrested accused have been identified as Farman of Vijaypur, Hameed, Fareed

& Shabir of Bari Brahmana and Abinash of Samba.

While Abinash has been arrested by Samba police from Punjab for kidnapping and rape of minor girl student, Farman, Hameed, Fareed&Shabir have been arrested for murderous attacks and extortion.

Three cases --- case FIR No.132/2023 under sections 307, 382, 353, 332, 148, 149, 34 IPC, case FIR No.244/2023 under sections 307, 323, 341, 147, 148, 382 IPC and case FIR No.233/2023 under sections 363,376 IPC, 3/4 POCSO Act have been registered at Police Station Vijaypur, Police Station Bari Brahmana and Police Station Samba respectively.

The accused have been arrested by police teams comprising of SHO Police Station Vijaypur Sandeep Charak, SHO Police Station Bari BrahmanaSumit Sharma, SHO Police Station Samba Daljit Singh and PSI Davinder Singh under the supervision of SDPO VijaypurRohit Kumar, SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul Nagar, DySPGaru Ram and Additional SP Samba SurinderChoudhary.

Inter district gang of bike lifters busted, 2 arrested, 8 vehicles recovered

MIRAN SAHIB: Police on Friday busted a gang of bike lifters by arresting two of its members and recovered 8 stolen two wheelers.

As per details, two different complaints were loaded at Police Station Miran Sahib on October 5, & 11 2023 by complainants namely Joginder Singh, son of Sain Dass, resident of Krishna Nagar, Miran Sahib, Tehsil RS Pura and Rimpy Bala, daughter of Girdhari Lal, resident of Dhindey Kalan Miran Sahib Jammu regarding theft of their motorcycles Bullet, bearing Regd. No. JK02BC-3881and Splendor bearing Registration No. JK02DB-6283.

On this, FIR No. 143 & 150 /2023 under section 379/IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Miran Sahib led by SDPO RS Pura Sh Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Miran Sahib Insrp Bopinder Singh, PSI Maroof Ahmed and PSI Mohd Altaf did hectic efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area arrested one person namely Farooq Ali, son of Nazir Hussain, resident of Simbal Camp. During questioning, accused confessed his involvement in above said case and on his disclosure stolen motorcycles bearing registration No.



JK02BC-3881 and JK02DB- 6283 were recovered from his possession.

Moreover 5 more motorcycles have been recovered on his disclosure and on his disclosure one more person namely Ranjit Singh alias Shotu, son of Jagdish Singh, resident of Thathi Seshwan Rajbagh was also arrested who used to purchase these stolen bikes and further sells them.

The recovered Bikes include JK02CB 3881(Bullet); JK02DF 8193 (Bullet); Chasis no. MBLHAR086HHL58116 (Splendor); JK02CM 7933 (Splendor); JK02DB 6283; chasis no. MBLHAR08XHHJ23814 (Splendor); Chasis no. ME4JC894HCG02F206; Chasis no. MBLHLAWW097KH903343(Splendor).

The overall arrests and recoveries were made under the supervision of SP Hqrs Rannish Gupta.

Missing woman traced, reunited with family

Two narco smugglers nabbed with 80 grams heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police achieved major success by recovering 80 grams of heroin while on during petrolling duty at JDA Parking Rail Head Complex from two accused persons from the area.
