

TNWS presents charter of demands to Union Minister

JAMMU: In a recent visit to the residence of Dr. Jitendra Singh, Union Minister, members of the Trikuta Nagar Welfare Society (TNWS), a registered organization in Jammu, extended their best wishes and presented a memento to commemorate the successful Chandrayaan 3 mission. On this auspicious occasion, coinciding with the first day of Navratri, the TNWS delegation discussed several pressing concerns and submitted a list of long-pending demands, emphasizing the necessity of addressing these issues to foster the growth of their fully established Trikuta Nagar community. During their interaction with the Union Minister, the TNWS team highlighted various challenges and presented demands crucial for the development and well-being of their Trikuta Nagar neighborhood. Dr. Jitendra Singh, being a resident of Trikuta Nagar himself, was seen as the voice of hope for the various issues.

The TNWS has called for a

ed with freehold rights, which are currently deemed excessive. They highlighted that many Trikutla Nagar residents are senior citizens and retired pensioners who struggle to meet the high fees. The proposal recommends a thorough review of the fees set by the Board of Directors of the Jammu Development Authority (JDA), suggesting that setting the fee at one lakh rupees for one kanal of land would be reasonable and widely acceptable to the residents.

The urban health training center in Trikutā Nagar has been requested to be elevated to an Urban Health Community Centre. This transformation would include the appointment of specialist doctors and an adequate staff to cater to the healthcare needs of the fully established colony. Recognizing the need for recreational spaces within the colony, the TNWS has proposed the creation of a mini play field. The envisioned facility would encompass a basketball court, a badminton court, and a skating rink, catering to the interests of the youth and children residing in the area. Residents have expressed concerns about the ongoing parking issues, especially in the narrow lanes of Trikutā Nagar. To address this problem, they have called for the construction of a multi-car parking complex in the main market of the colony.

Due to a decrease in the water level from existing

water pumps, the TNWS has emphasized the necessity of installing a new borewell in Ward 54. This would help alleviate the drinking water supply shortage currently experienced by residents.

The absence of an equipped ayurvedic hospital in south Jammu has prompted a demand for the establishment of such a facility within Trikuta Nagar to cater to the healthcare needs of the local population.

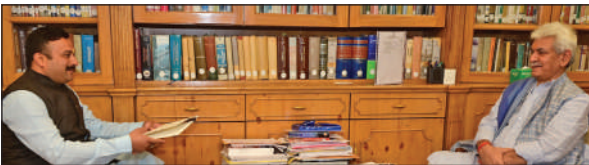
The widening of the Nallalabridge, situated at the junction of sectors 4-5 in Wards 53-54 of Trikuta Nagar, has been discussed as a critical safety measure. This bridge, connecting six roads, has been

associated with accidents, and the TNWS has called for the attention of both the Public Works Department (R & B) and the Public Health Engineering departments.

Residents have urged the urgent introduction of a Vande Bharat Express train route from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Katra to Jammu and Chandigarh. This direct train connection would serve the needs of students, senior citizens seeking medical treatment in Chandigarh, and promote religious tourism in the Jammu and Kashmir Union Territory. The Union Minister received the list of demands and assured the residents of prompt action, given his own residence within Trikuta Nagar. The interaction session was led by Rajinder Parshad Kakkar, President of TNWS, and attended by a gathering that included Er. Ashok Kumar Arora, Vijay Gupta, Amarjeet Singh, Dr. Arun Gandotra, Er. Varinder Kumar Suri, and Harshvardhan Gupta, an advocate.

The Secretary of TNWS Jammu facilitated the visit and the productive interaction, leaving residents hopeful that their concerns will receive the attention they deserve.

Court upholds detention under PSA for individual involved in terrorism

JAMMU: In a recent legal ruling, Justice Sanjay Dhar of the Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh High Court dismissed a petition filed by Showkat Ali, an individual allegedly involved in militant activities. The court's decision was made after a careful examination of the grounds of detention, which cited Showkat Ali's connections with relatives engaged in militancy.

Justice Sanjay Dhar's ruling was based on several key points. Allegedly, Showkat Ali was in contact with his cousin brothers, who had joined militant activities in the past and were currently settled in Pakistan. The grounds of detention suggested that Showkat Ali maintained these contacts to potentially revive militancy in District Reasi.

The court noted that specific and clear information regarding Showkat Ali's activities and his alleged connections had been recorded in three daily diary reports dated February 1, 2023, February 6, 2023, and February 11, 2023. These reports were registered with the Police Station in Mahore.

Showkat Ali was provided

with all relevant material, including the detention order, notice of detention, grounds of detention, and other associated documents through an Executing Officer.

The records indicated that he had executed a receipt acknowledging the receipt of these documents.

The court observed that the contents of the provided documents had been read out to Showkat Ali and explained to him in the Gojri language, which he understood. This process was clearly recorded in the receipt of grounds of detention, bearing his signature.

An affidavit from Inspector Karnail Singh confirmed that Showkat Ali had been briefed about the grounds of detention in the Gojri language, which he fully comprehended. The affidavit further stated that all documents had been provided to him.

In light of this information and the available material, the court found no merit in Showkat Ali's petition and subsequently dismissed it. Showkat Ali's detention under the Public Safety Act (PSA) was upheld by the Jammu & Kashmir High Court.





Whereas, Committee has submitted the preliminary report vide No. TH/PA/2023-24/10 dated 28-07-2023, mentioning that the proposed land is already under the possession of Indenting Department with the consent of the proprietors of the land, there is no displacement or rehabilitation involved and no adverse impact of acquisition either socially or ecologically and Committee has recommended for acquisition of land for the said project.
