CRIME REPORT

Two persons impersonating as IPS officer, Insp arrested

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday arrested two fake police officers in Jammu who were impersonating as a Police Inspector and an Indian Police Officer (IPS) officer. Both the accused have been arrested from a hotel in Jewel area of Jammu. SSP Jammu Chandan Kohli said that a complaint was lodged at Police Station Nowabad by one person stating that two persons who were portraying themselves as IPS officer and Inspector were threatening him.

In his complaint, the victim person had stated that he met a person namely Kaiser Jeelani on a social networking site who portrayed himself as IPS officer and he became friend with that person and finally he met him in Hotel Green Mint Gumat near Fish Market. On entering the room he saw Kaiser Jeelani and one more person in Police uniform with stars who portrayed himself as Inspector after which Kaiser Jeelani who told him that they both are in NIA.

The duo threatened him to give them his laptop and on this context they were harassing him. The complainant was further threatened by the two men of putting him in lockup if he fails to follow their words and that they even can shoot him.

In this regard, FIR NO. 166/2023 U/S 419/420/384/170/171 IPC was registered at PS Nowabad and investigation was started.

In investigation of the case, special police teams of Police Station Nowabad led by SP Kulbir Handa, DySP HQrs Dr. Sunniya Wani assisted by SHO Nowabad Surinder Raina did strenuous efforts and finally arrested accused from the said place. Accused arrested were identified as Kaiser Shahnavaz Mir resident of Danger Pora Baramulla and Mohd Tanveer alias Arif Wani resident of Sopore Baramulla.



Two arrested with illicit liquor

AKHNOOR: Police on Tuesday detained two bootleggers and recovered 74 bottles of illicit liquor from their possessions.

As per details, an information was received through reliable sources that one person namely Madan Singh, son of Rakha Singh, resident of Devipur Akhnoor is selling illicit liquor on his meat shop at Village Devipur. On this information a case FIR No.268/2023 under section 48-A, 48-F Excise Act was registered in Police Station Akhnoor. During investigation a party of Police Station Akhnoor led by SHO Insp Zaheer Mushtaq under the supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal Sharma arrested the accused person namely Madan Singh, son of Rakha Singh, resident of

Devipur and also recovered 25 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession.

Meanwhile, a party of Police Station Vijaypur while on patrolling duty in Vijaypur area during night hours has recovered 49 bottles illicit liquor which were being sold near Matador Stand Vijaypur Ramgarh road by one Pankaj Sharma alias Batly, son of Ram Dass, resident of Gurha Morh Vijaypur to the general public at exorbitant rates to gain illegitimate profit. However the accused managed to escape from the spot on seeing the police party. FIR No. 134/2023 under section 48 (F) Excise Act has been registered at Police Station Vijaypur and investigation started to nab the accused.

Three narco smugglers nabbed, 15 gm heroin recovered

REASI: Continuing the drive against drug abuse launched by District Police Reasi, Police on Tuesday arrested 3 notorious drug peddlers and recovered 15 gm Heroin (Chitta) from their possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Katra apprehended one person namely Sumit Sharma, son of Mohan Lal, resident of Searli Katra apprehended at Police Check Post Searli Naka and from his possession 05 gram heroin/Chitta was recovered. FIR No. 308/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Katra. In another incident, Police apprehended two persons namely Divansh Sharma, son of Vipan Sharma, resident of Ward No. 2 Tea Garden Katra and Madhav Thakur, son of Brij Mohan, resident of Matyal Tehsil Katra apprehended at Police Check Post Nomain Naka and from their possession 5/5 gram Heroin/chitta recovered. FIR No. 307/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Katra. The whole operation was led by SHO Katra Insp. Nishant Gupta under the supervision of SDPO Katra Surinder Singh and overall supervision of Vipan Chandran SP Katra.

4 rustlers arrested; stolen sheep worth lakh recovered

GANDERBAL: Police on Tuesday solved a burglary case by arresting 04 rustlers and recovered 16 stolen sheep from their possession.

As per details, On September 22 2023, Police Station Lar received a written complaint from Mohammad Iqbal Thekri son of Makhan Thekri resident of Kathua at present Yangoora Lar stating therein that few days ago, during the night hours some unknown thieves barged into his cowshed and had stolen 16 Sheep worth lakh.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 55/2023 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Lar.

During the course of investigation, a team was constituted under the supervision of DySP HQrs Ganderbal led by SHO Lar, on the directions of SSP Ganderbal Nikhil Borkar. After strenuous efforts, the Police team apprehended four persons identified as Mudasir Ahmad Dar son of Gh Rasool Dar resident of Ari Goripora Kangan, Shabir Ahmad Mir son of Ab Khaliq Mir resident of Ari Goripora Kangan, Imtiyaz Ahmad Mir son of Ab Rashid Mir resident of Ari Goripora Kangan and Riyaz Ahmad Damiyal son of Mohd Shafi Damiyal resident of Gund Aku.

During questioning, they admitted their involvement in the commission of crime. On their disclosure, stolen 16 sheep were recovered. The accused persons have been shifted to Police Station where they remain in custody.

Accused of hit and run case apprehended within hour of incident

AWANTIPORA: Police in Awantipora on Tuesday arrested an accused driver

involved in a hit and run case within an hour of the incident.

Earlier today, a road traffic accident took place at Reshipora in which one girl namely Adeeba Arshid (age about 10 years) daughter of Arshid Ahmad Shiekh resident of Reshipora was hit by a Dumper bearing registration number JK01AE-3177 driven rashly and negligently by Mohd Haneef Khanday son of Ali Mohd Khanday resident of Meej Pampore. In the incident, the girl died on the spot.

Acting swiftly, a Police team apprehended the accused driver within hour of the incident.

Accordingly, Police have taken a cognisance under relevant section of law besides, a dumper has also been seized.

Mystery behind Zelna case burglary solved, accused arrested

Kishtwar: Kishtwar Police have achieved a significant breakthrough in the investigation of the Zelna Case burglary, which occurred on the night of September 23rd and 24th, 2023. A complaint was filed at Police Station Kishtwar, detailing a disturbing incident where masked individuals forcibly entered a residence armed with rods, leading to the registration of Case FIR No. 226/2023 under section 3/25 I. A Act, 395/458/323/34/IPC at Police Station Kishtwar.

Thereafter, SSP Kishtwar, Khalil Poswal, formed a Special Investigation Team (SIT) headed by Dy. SP HQrs Kishtwar, Dr. Ishan Gupta, and Insp Parvaiz Ahmed Khanday, SHO PS Kishtwar, PSI Kanwar Rishiv under the supervision of IC Adtl. SP Kishtwar. The dedicated team of investigators worked tirelessly to uncover the details of this incident.

During the course

of the investigation, the SIT apprehended several suspects and eventually succeeded in arresting the thieves involved in the burglary case, leading to the recovery of stolen items.

The arrested individual has been identified as Akshay Kumar, son of Raj Kumar, resident of S a n g r a m b a t a Kishtwar, who, under custody of SIT, disclosed his involvement. Additionally, crucial information was divulged, leading to the identification of other accomplices involved in this heinous crime.

SSP Kishtwar stated that the SIT promptly arrested the other burglars who had initially escaped.SSP Kishtwar, Poswal, further emphasizes that the entire town is under CCTV coverage, with 24x7 monitoring by a specialized team at the CCTV surveillance unit of Kishtwar Police. This gang of thieves was also apprehended with the assistance of CCTV footage from in and around Kishtwar town.
