CRIME REPORT

Rohingya man booked for creating fake Aadhar, Ration cards

POONCH: Police on Friday nabbed a Rohingya man for creating fake aadhar and ration card at Gursai.

As per details, a Rohingya man namely Mohd Noman, son of Mohibullah, resident of Mayanagar who is living in the house of Nazir Hussain, son of Mohd Yousuf, resident of Dhargloon Tehsil Balakote who married Nazir Husain daughter namely Naseem Akhtar entered into the criminal conspiracy along with employees of different departments and prepared illegal/ forged documents Le Adhaar card and Ration card. He was arrested and FIR No 117/2023 u/s 420,465,468,471,109,120-B IPC was registered against him at Police Station Gursai. More arrests are expected in the above case and all those who were part of criminal conspiracy and forgery shall be taken to legal determination.

Bootlegger arrested with 44 bottles of illicit liquor

BARI BRAHMANA: Police on Friday arrested a bootlegger and recovered 44 bottles of illicit liquor from his possession. The arrested accused person has been identified as Ravi Kumar, son of Tilak Raj, resident of Tibba Deoli Tehsil Bishnah district Jammu.

Acting on a tip-off information about sale of illicit liquor in SIDCO Industrial area Bari Brahmana, a party of Police Station Bari Brahmana headed by SHO Bari Brahmana Sumit Sharma under the supervision of SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul Nagar and Additional SP Samba Surinder Choudhary rushed to the spot and caught red-handed the accused person from his own 'Dhaba' selling illicit liquor to the general public in the area and recovered 44 bottles of liquor from his possession. FIR No. 236/2023 under section 48(f) Excise Act was registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana and investigation started.

2 Narco smugglers nabbed with heroin

KATHUA/AKHNOOR: Police on Friday recovered Heroin (Chitta) like narcotics



from two narco smugglers at Kathua and Akhnoor.

As per details, an information received through the reliable sources at Police Post Hatli that one person Namely Amardeep Singh alias Faroli, son of Amulak Singh, resident of Ward No. 11 Near Bus Stand Kathua District Kathua doing illegal trade of selling Narcotics contraband and kept intermediate quantity of narcotics substance in his possession. Acting swiftly, a police team led by PSI Swaran Singh Manhas In-Charge Police Post Hatli under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Manjeet Singh and Insp. Sudhir Sadhotra SHO Kathua during Naka/ checking at ward No. 13 Berrian Pattan area apprehended said person namely Amardeep Singh near Bus Stand Kathua District Kathua who was roaming under suspicious circumstances. While frisking approx. 9.88 grams of Heroin(Chitta) narcotics was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 434/2023 under sections 8/21/22/ NDPS Act has been registered at Police Station Kathua while further investigation is underway.

Meanwhile, a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Sharma assisted by SHO Police Station Akhnoor Insp. Zaheer Mushtaq while on Naka duty at Daskal near fruit Mandi Akhnoor rounded up one suspect. On search, 08 grams of heroin was recovered from them. FIR No 272/2023 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered in Police Station Akhnoor and accused was arrested who has been identified as Sharief Din alias Shariefu, son of Wali Mohd, resident of Beli Charana District Jammu.

Theft case solved; accused held, stolen items recovered

BISHNAH: Police on Friday solved a theft case by arresting an accused and recovered stolen items.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Bishnah from a person namely Suresh Kumar, son of Waryam Dass, resident of Village Pandorian Tehsil Bishnah stating that some unknown thief has stolen Stabilizer, Inverter, Battery and Cash from Shri Peer Baba Situated at Village Morehapur. FIR No. 224/2023 under section 379 IPC has been registered and investigation started.

On this, a team of Police Station Bishnah led by SDPO R.S Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Bishnah Insp. Vikram Sharma did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally rounded up one suspected person namely Tirth Ram, son of Sewa Ram, resident of Village Chak Avtara Tehsil Bishnah District Jammu. During questioning accused confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure stolen items got recovered from his possession.

Man dies after jumping into Jhelum

SRINAGAR: A 35-year-old man on Friday died after jumping into a river Jhelum near Abdullah Bridge in Rajbagh area of Srinagar, officials said.

As per details, a man identified as Rameez Raja Ganie, a resident of Pampoore,

presently living at Sari Bala Srinagar, ended his life by jumping into River Jhelum, near Rajbagh. Soon after the incident a team of SDRF along with River Police Srinagar, swung into action and retrieved the body. Meanwhile, police have taken cognisance of the incident and further investigation is on in this regard.

Army officer who fired on soldiers in Rajouri to face Court of Inquiry

RAJOURI: A Court of Inquiry was ordered on Friday against an army major for allegedly opening fire on his colleagues and injuring five personnel, including three officers, inside a camp in Rajouri district of Jammu and Kashmir, officials said.

Tension had gripped areas around the Neeli post in the Thanamandi area on Thursday and senior officials rushed to the camp for first-hand information about the incident, which the army had initially sought to downplay as an accidental grenade blast that left one officer injured.

According to information gathered through various sources, the major, who has been identified as 'Prince', created a hue and cry about a possible terror attack prompting his commanding officer to rush his second-in-command from Thanamandi, located 18 km from the Neeli post.

Attempts were made to pacify the officer who seemed to be in some panic attack. The erring officer had ensured that all weapons in the post were deposited in the armoury.

As soon as attempts were made to pacify him, he is alleged to have started indiscriminate firing and lobbing grenades leading to injuries of two middle-rung personnel and the unit's second-in-command.

This prompted the commanding officer of the unit, along with the Regimental Medical Officer (RMO), to rush to the scene. They too were injured and are believed to have received splinter injuries.

The injured were taken to Thanamandi, from where three were airlifted to the Command Hospital in Udhampur.

The erring officer has been detained and is being questioned, the officials said, adding a Court of Inquiry has been ordered into the incident.

The tense situation at the camp lasted nearly eight hours before the officer was overpowered inside the armoury late in the evening on Thursday.

The army posted on X late Thursday night that an officer was injured in a likely grenade accident at a post in Rajouri.

"On 05 Oct 23 one officer was injured in a likely grenade accident at a post in Rajouri sector. Officer evacuated and stable post initial treatment. Further investigation of the incident in progress," the White Knight Corps of the army posted on X.

Official sources said there was a firing practice session at the camp for the past several days and the accused officer started firing on his colleagues and subordinates without any provocation on Thursday afternoon.

Later, he took shelter inside the armoury of the camp and hurled grenades when the commanding officer, along with his deputy and the medical officer, moved near the building in an effort to persuade him to surrender, the sources said.

On the incident, Jammu-based defence PRO Lt Col Suneel Bartwal said in a message on Thursday night, "I have received calls about some firing/terrorist attack on army camp in General Area Rajouri. I would like to inform you that no terrorist attack has occurred, it is an unfortunate internal incident of the camp."
