

GRP Jammu solves theft case; 3 nabbed,

stolen golden/silver ornaments recovered STATE TIMES NEWS GRPThursday solved a theft case by arresting three accused and recovered golden/silver ornaments

from their possession. On As per details, October 7, 2022, a complainant (name withheld) appeared at Police Station GRP Jammu and produced a written application stating that her gold/silver



ornaments have been stolen by unknown thieves in a running train at Platform No.01 Railway station Jammu. On receiving the application, FIR No.15/2022 under section 380 IPC was registered at Police Station GRP Jammu and subsequently investigation started. During the course of investigation, number of suspects were interrogated and technical evidences were collected. In this regard a SIT was constituted by SSP Railway Jammu Mohan Lal Kaith under the overall supervision of Albeena Malik, SDPO Railway Jammu. During investigation team headed by Inspector Madan Lal went to Haryana and conducted several raids. On October 3, 2023, three accused were arrested who disclosed their involvement. After hectic efforts all the ornaments worth Rs.1.70 lakhs were recovered. The continuous strenuous efforts made by team of GRP including Niaz Ahmed SHO Police Station GRP Jammu in last three months made it possible to recover more than 200 gms of golden ornaments
