JAMMU: Arun Gupta, President of the Chamber of Commerce & Industry (CCI), Jammu has expressed strong support for the recent decision by Jammu Smart City Ltd. to replace old electric poles with new installations. He emphasized that this initiative is expected to streamline electrical supply and reduce unnecessary faults. In his statement, Gupta highlighted the presence of numerous old electric poles in the city, particularly in areas like Canal Road and Gandhi Nagar, which are no longer in use by the Power Development Department (PDD) or any other agency. He noted that these unused poles are not only a safety hazard but also obstruct traffic flow and pedestrian movement. "We

request the authorities to remove these non-functional electric poles to enhance the free movement in our streets," he said.

Additionally, Gupta raised concerns about the rising cases of Dengue and Chikungunya in Jammu district. He called for immediate action to combat these health issues, urging the Jammu Municipal Corporation to intensify fogging operations throughout municipal areas. "There is an urgent need to take concrete steps to control the spread of these diseases, especially as cases continue to rise," he stated.
