

JU organises special lecture on "Indus Water Treaty: Emerging India's Concerns"

JAMMU: The Department of Strategic and Regional Studies (DSRS) at the University of Jammu organized a significant lecture titled "Indus Water Treaty: Emerging India's Concerns." The event featured former Director General of Police for Jammu and Kashmir, Dr. S. P. Vaid, as the Chief Guest, with eminent journalist Sant Kumar Sharma providing a detailed analysis of the Indus Water Treaty (IWT). The discussion was facilitated by Prof. Virender Koundal, Director of DSRS, who set the thematic stage for the lecture. Dr. S. P. Vaid emphasized the multifaceted challenges India faces concerning Pakistan, including issues of terrorism, counterfeit currency, and narco-terrorism. He underscored the importance of revisiting the Indus Water Treaty to safeguard India's national interests, suggesting that a timely review is necessary to address evolving geopolitical dynamics. In his presentation, Sant Kumar Sharma delved into India's recent actions under Article XII (3) of the IWT, which allows for treaty modifications—a provision that has remained untouched since the treaty's inception in 1960. Notably, India issued a notice to Pakistan on August 31, 2024, invoking this article due to ongoing tensions surrounding hydropower projects on the Chenab River. Sharma highlighted that the treaty's final article permits modifications through a duly ratified agreement, reiterating that this course of action is well within the treaty's framework. Sharma also reflected on the historical context of the treaty, clarifying that perceptions of smooth relations between India and Pakistan are misleading. He noted that a decade ago, India had informed Pakistan about the Kishenganga hydel project and the Ratle project on the Chenab, which sparked

objections from Pakistan and escalated tensions. The treaty includes a dispute resolution mechanism under Article IX, outlining a three-step process involving the Permanent Indus Commission, a Neutral Expert, and ultimately, a Court of Arbitration. However, Sharma pointed out that Pakistan has initiated actions at both the second and third levels of this mechanism simultaneously, creating a conflict within the treaty's provisions. India views this approach as a violation of the treaty, complicating the dispute resolution process. Prof. Koundal expressed gratitude to the speakers and presented mementos to Dr. Vaid and Sharma in recognition of their valuable insights. The event began with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp and tributes to Bharat Mata and Saraswati Mata, led by Dr. Vaid, Prof. Koundal, and Sharma, among other dignitaries. It was well-attended by faculty members, including Dr. Mohd. Monir Alam, Dr. Surinder Mohan, Dr. Ganesh Malhotra, and Dr. Ranjan Sharma, along with non-teaching staff, postgraduate students, and research scholars from DSRS. Dr. Ganesh Malhotra skillfully conducted the proceedings and delivered the vote of thanks, effectively concluding a thought-provoking session on a topic of great national importance.
