SRINAGAR: Stage is set for Omar Abdullah to take oath as the first chief minister of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir following the victory of his National Conference in the maiden assembly election after the abrogation of Article 370.

CM to chair meeting of Administrative Secretaries after oath ceremony

JAMMU: The Government of Jammu and Kashmir has scheduled an important meeting tomorrow under the leadership of the newly sworn-in Chief Minister.

"After the Oath-taking Ceremony, the Chief Minister, J&K, shall chair a meeting of all Administrative Secretaries on October 16, 2024 (Wednesday) at 3:00 PM in the Meeting Hall, 3rd Floor, Civil Secretariat, Srinagar," read the notification issued by Rohit Sharma, Additional Secretary, General Administration Department.

"Accordingly, all the Administrative Secretaries are requested to attend the meeting on the scheduled date, time and venue," it added.

Rahul, Kharge, Priyanka to attend swearing-in ceremony

JAMMU: Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi, Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge and party general secretary Priyanka Gandhi are scheduled to attend the oath-taking ceremony of CM-elect Omar Abdullah in Srinagar on Wednesday, a senior party leader said.

"Rahul Gandhi, Kharge ji, and Priyanka ji are scheduled to participate in the oath ceremony tomorrow," a senior Congress leader said.

He said that some chief ministers and representatives of some states will also attend the event. The party high command will convey the decision on ministerial berths for Congress MLAs in the new government, he added.

Centre (SKICC) on Wednesday, officials said.

The Chief Minister and his ministers will be administered the oath of office and secrecy by J-K Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha at 11:30 am.

Security has been tightened around the venue of the swearing-in ceremony, the officials said.

"The security has been beefed up especially as a lot of VVIPs will be attending the event. We will ensure the smooth conduct of the event," the officials added.

Invitations to attend the oath ceremony have been sent to the constituents of the INDIA bloc.

Speaking at the inauguration of the International Telecommunication Union - WTSA and India Mobile Congress here, he favoured clear 'dos' and

'don'ts' to safeguard citizens. "There is a need for a global framework... guidelines for

the importance of a rule-based framework for digital technology."



digital technology," he said. "Time has come when global institutions have to accept

Digital rules are important not just because they involve personal privacy, media disinformation, the accountability of tech giants and other issues of societal importance, but also because trade in goods and services rely on international flows of data.
