

Rs 40 lakh crore in investment proposals reflects growing interest in UP: Yogi

LUCKNOW: Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday said that the increasing interest of investors from around the world in the state is evident with investment proposals worth Rs 40 lakh crore that were received during last year's Global Investors Summit.

Addressing an event here in Lucknow, Yogi Adityanath said, these proposals not only highlight the state's progress but also reveal the journey of its transformative development journey.

He stated that in the past seven years, Uttar Pradesh has seen major changes that have improved its reputation both in India and around the world. As a result, investors from across the globe are now drawn to invest in the state. Apart from this, at present, investment proposals of Rs 10 lakh crore are ready.

Highlighting these investments, he said that they not only concern economic growth but also represent vast job opportunities for the state's youth.

NOTIFICATION

Subject: Constitution of Committee in case titled "Kirmania Model High School, Batwina, Ganderbal V/s Union Territory of J&K and others".

Whereas, by virtue of S.O 177 notified on 15.04.2022, Section 2B was added to The J&K School Education Rules 2010, mandating that the applications for grant of Affiliation/ Recognition shall be accompanied by a no-objection certificate regarding land use issued by the Revenue Department.

Whereas, various school managements in the U.T of J&K failed to furnish the requisite NOC from Revenue Department and thereby extension in affiliation/ recognition in respect of these schools could not be granted.

Whereas, with a view to protect the academic interest of students enrolled in these schools, tagging with the nearby Government schools was implemented as a provisional measure.

Whereas, in the meanwhile many such schools located on Kahcharia/State/Shamilat land filed writ petitions in the Hon'ble Court of Jammu and Kashmir, challenging provisions of S.O 177.

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu and Kashmir disposed the writ petitions (clubbed) vide judgement dated 08.08.2024, the operative part of which reads as under;

".....where the schools being run on Kahcharie/State/Shamilat etc. Land are concerned, the petitioners therein can either acquire the proprietary land and/ or approach the respondent-authority (Principal Secretary to Government Department of Education, U.T of J&K/ J&K Board of School Education) with their plea as is made by them in their respective writ petitions for consideration which can also include the exchange of proprietary land in lieu of Kahcharie/ State/ Shamilat etc. Land, as may be available under and in terms of the Land Revenue Act or any other applicable law(s). All these requests/ applications shall be made by the petitioners within four weeks from today. Principal Secretary to Government, Department of School Education, U.T of J&K/ J&K Board of School Education, on receipt of such application(s), shall decide the same either himself/ itself or by constituting a Committee, comprising of senior officers of the School Education Department/J&K Board of School Education, Revenue Department or any other departments(s) as may be thought appropriate by him/ it, and get such applications decided within four months. While doing so, the petitioner(s) shall also be heard.

It is made clear here that in the event any of the writ petitioners makes the same proposal as has been made by the petitioner in WP(C) no. 3250/2023, such a case will be governed and regulated by the directions passed herein above in WP(C) no. 3250/2023.

Till then petitioner(s) be permitted to run the school(s) provided they are able to do so having regard to change of circumstances during pendency of instant matter as the students studying in those schools have been shifted to other schools.

With regard to the writ petitions/ cases, where Kahcharie/ State/ Shamilat land etc. is not involved, they (writ petitioners therein) can also approach Principal Secretary to Government, Department of School Education, U.T of J&K/ J&K Board of School Education, with their request/plea within four weeks from today. On receipt of such application(s), he/it shall either himself/ itself decide or get such application(s) decided through the Committee, to be constituted by him/it, within a period of four months and while doing so, petitioner(s) shall also be heard. Till then petitioner(s) be permitted to run the school(s) provided they are able to do so having regard to change of circumstances during pendency of instant matter as the students studying in those schools have been shifted to other schools....."

Whereas, as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court dated 08.08.2024 the School Education Department vide Circular No: 06-JK(Edu) of 2024 dated 19.09.2024 has notified for information of all stakeholders, "that JKBOSE shall grant Provisional affiliation, as a one time exemption, to all such schools which are without a valid affiliation, both for the earlier academic session 2023-24 (when they were tagged with the nearby government school) and current academic session 2024-25, for non-conformity to provisions of SO 177. Further, JKBOSE shall extend all board related facilities viz; Registration Return (RR) forms, eligibility, migration and examination to such schools for sessions 2023-24 and 2024-25, for classes 9th to 12th. It is clarified that this exemption/ provisional affiliation is subject to the decision of the Proposed Committee to be constituted by the General Administration Department, as directed by the Hon'ble High Court and may be rescinded if the committee arrives at a contrary decision".

Whereas, a committee headed by the Chairman, J&K Board of School Education has been constituted by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir, General Administration Department, Civil Secretariat, J&K vide Government Order No. 1703-JK(GAD) of 2024 dated 04.10.2024, with the following terms of reference:

- To examine the applications so received, on case to case basis as per the extant rules in the UT of Jammu and Kashmir and submit the report along-with specific recommendations, individually on case to case basis, to the Government not later than two (02) months.
- To seek details/ documents from the institutions, as felt necessary for examination of the cases.
- The committee while examining the representation shall given opportunity of being heard to each applicant.

It is therefore, notified for information of all the stakeholders/ heads of all such private schools (high and higher Secondary) which are without a valid affiliation for non-conformity to provisions of S.O 177 that they shall submit their representation to the office of the Joint Secretary, General, Jammu Division at Rehari Colony and the Joint Secretary, General, Kashmir Division at Bemina, as the case may be, during office hours within a period of 15 days from the date of issuance of this notification.
