SRINAGAR: In recognition of the high standards of quality and performance maintained by the two Health Institutions of Srinagar District, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has awarded Urban Primary Health Centre (UPHC) Lal Bazar and UPHC Batamaloo with the National Quality Assurance Standard (NQAS) Certification.

The allotment of 05 marks to the candidates (pursuant to their claims through online/office modes) as reflected in the Annexure are purely provisional and shall not entitle the candidates to any right of preferential treatment for selection. Final allotment shall be made only after verification of requisite documents/mark sheets/degree certificates by the concerned Document Verification Committees at the time of Document Verification.

It is further notified that:

- mere figuring in the result/score sheet shall not entitle a candidate to be called for document verification or figure in the selection list and that he/she has to fulfill other eligibility conditions, as laid down with respect to production of requisite year wise/semester wise mark sheets/degree certificates or any other certificate at the time of Document verification and decision of the Board in this regard shall be final.
- Merit of those candidates who fail to produce requisite documents in support of their claims for award of additional 05 marks, shall be drawn after deduction of 05 marks for the purpose of selection.
- the Jammu & Kashmir Services Selection Board (JKSSB) will call candidates falling in the consideration zone, based on the merit obtained by them in the written examination and provisional allotment of 05 marks as per the notified criteria, for Document Verification. Subject: Fixation/Re-fixation of Combined Seniority at the level of +2 Lecturers/Sr. Lecturers in the School Education Department.

NOTICE

Whereas, the applicant/petitioner (Mr. Raghu Nandan) filed O.A No. 61/1353/2022 before the Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal and has sought following reliefs in the matter:

"By way of instant O.A, the applicant is seeking a direction to respondents to consider his claim for grant of seniority benefits as Lecturer 10+2 Geography retrospectively from the date the other candidates who participated in the selection process for the post of Lecturer 10+2 Geography pursuant to Notification No.07-PSC of 2009, dated 09.03.2009 have been appointed."

Whereas, The Hon'ble Central Administrative Tribunal vide order dated 27.09.2022 has disposed of the OA with the following directions:

"..... I have considered the submissions made by the Ld. Counsels for both the sides and perused the material on record. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the O.A. is disposed of at Admission stage with direction to respondents to treat a copy of this O.A. as representation of the applicant and decide it, as per relevant rules, regulations and instructions on the subject, by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. A copy of speaking order be communicated to the applicant within one week thereafter. "

Whereas, the petitioner is seeking seniority benefits as 10+2 Lecturer (Geography) retrospectively from the date his other counterparts have been appointed vide Government Order No.806-Edu of 2009, dated 24.11.2009.

Whereas, the claim/grievance of the petitioner Mr. Raghu Nandan is seeking seniority benefits as 10+2 Lecturer (Geography) retrospectively from the date his other counterparts have been appointed vide Government Order No.806-Edu of 2009, dated 24.11.2009 issued vide No.PSC/DP/Lect 10+2/Geography/2009 dated 16.11.2009 and whose selection was withheld.

Whereas, thereafter a notice dated 02.04.2024 regarding re-fixation of seniority of the incumbent was issued for inviting objections from members of the cadre. In response to the notice dated 02.04.2024 one Syed Safura, Lecturer Computer Science submitted her objection saying her case which is identical and similar in nature is pending and has been recommended by DSEK as well as JKPCS for restoration of seniority as per merit in the selection list of Public Service Commission i.e. over and above at Serial No.2482 instead of 2627.

Whereas, after thorough perusal of the objection/documents, the case of objector namely Syed Safura Lecturer Computer Science regarding re-fixation of seniority, who was selected in another selection process vide notification No.16-PSC(DR-S) of 2013 dated 14.02.2013.

Whereas, her co-selectee namely Mohd Ayoub Khan (RBA) was selected as Lecturer (Computer Science) vide notice published by JKPCS dated 16.09.2011 and thereafter figuring at Seniority No.2482, Final Seniority List of +2 Lecturers issued.

Whereas, the result of Open Merit candidates withheld in pursuance of Hon'ble Court orders dated 03.08.2011 in SWP No.1916/2011 and released vide notification No.16-PSC(DR-S) of 2013 dated 14.02.2013.

Whereas, as per the information/service particulars of officers namely Raghu Nandan as well as Syed Safura Lecturer Computer Science, the seniority of the officer is to be re-fixed in the Government Order No.22-Edu of 2021, dated 27.01.2021 and Government Order No.183-Edu of 2024 dated 13.03.2024 regarding final seniority of +2 Lecturer/Senior Lecturer of School Education Department:
