

CS asks to identify tribal areas for establishment of new residential schools

SRINAGAR: Chief Secretary, Atal Dulloo, on Monday asked the Deputy Commissioners to identify the tribal inhabited areas in their districts for establishment of Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) meant to impart quality education to the students belonging to the community.

The Chief Secretary issued these instructions while chairing a meeting of Tribal Affairs Department here at Civil Secretariat in this regard. The meeting besides Secretary, Tribal Affairs was attended by Secretary, PWD; Secretary, RDD; Secretary, Revenue; Deputy Commissioners; MD, JKRLM and other concerned officers.

During the meeting, the Chief Secretary exhorted upon the Deputy Commissioners to come up with comprehensive DPRs for establishment of new EMRS in their areas dominated by the tribal population.

He impressed upon them to simultaneously identify the land patches suitable for construction of such schools so that the students from this section of the society too get an opportunity of obtaining quality education nearer to their homes.

He enquired from the

DCs about the tribal dominated areas in their respective districts and implored upon them to look into the possibility of establishing these residential schools there exclusively with the aid of central government.

He also enjoined upon them to look into the necessity of renovation of existing EMRS in their areas besides the tribal hostels requiring the facility.

He directed for forwarding the detailed proposals to the Department here so that requisite funding is sought from the concerned Ministry.

Secretary, Tribal Affairs, Prasanna Ramaswamy G, informed in the meeting that the central government facilitates construction of the EMRS in blocks having more than 50% tribal population or 20,000 ST individuals

Creore for establishment of Tribal multi-purpose marketing Centre for retailing, value addition of products being made by this population.

He asked the DCs to identify land measuring 1.5 acres for the same in their areas for directly benefitting these people associated with SHGs etc.

It was further revealed that vetted proposals, in this regard, should be sent by the concerned Deputy Commissioners so that same are forwarded to the Ministry for funding within the stipulated deadline after making of other requisite formalities by the Tribal Affairs Department.

Know Dengue for no Dengue We can prevent ourselves from Dengue

DENGUE

- Dengue is a viral disease.
- It is transmitted by the bite of Aedes mosquito.
- Dengue Fever is a severe, flu-like illness.
- Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever & Dengue Shock Syndrome are more severe forms of disease, which may cause death if not treated properly in time.

Dengue manifests in three forms:

- Classical Dengue fever (majority of cases are of this type and can be treated at home).
- Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever (severe type needs admission).
- Dengue Shock Syndrome (severe type needs admission).

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS

- Dengue Classical fever:**
 - High grade fever.
 - Pain behind the eyes which worsens with eye movement.
 - Muscle and joint pains.
 - Pain abdomen.
- Dengue Hemorrhagic Fever:**
 - Bleeding through Gums/nose
 - blood in vomiting
 - small hemorrhagic spots over skin
 - blood in stools (black motion).
 - abdominal pain
 - Low BP, shock
- Dengue Shock Syndrome:**
 - Cold clammy limbs,
 - feeble pulse
 - low B.P, shock
 - if not treated timely and properly can lead to death.
 - unconsciousness

PREVENTION

- Avoid water stagnation in & around the house.
- Empty water reservoirs regularly like storage utensils, air coolers, plant pots, drums, flower pots and bird baths etc. Destroy and dispose off junk items like old tyres, coconut shells, disposable glasses and used cold drink bottles etc.
- Keep water tanks and other water containers tightly covered with lids.
- Use mosquito repellents/ Anti mosquito creams.
- On leaving home, do not wear clothes that expose arms and legs.
- Use mosquito nets while sleeping.
- Use netted screens for doors & windows to prevent entry of mosquitoes.
- Avoid sleeping on terrace to prevent mosquito bites.

Management

- On having symptoms of dengue go to the nearby health institution.
- The tests and treatment are available free of cost in Govt. Health Institutions.
- Don't go for self medication.
- For first aid for high grade fever in inaccessible areas and during odd hours you can use tablet Paracetamol and tepid sponging.
- Don't take pain killers and any other medicines without the consultation of Doctors.
- Most of the Dengue cases are mild and can be treated at home.
- Once the fever subsides, the patient needs to be more careful as this is "Lull before the Storm". The severe types of Dengue can develop after the fever is over. Consult doctor immediately in case of symptoms of severe type of Dengue. Patient can resume daily activities only after 2 weeks of onset of fever.
- Take adequate fluids like coconut water, lassi, fruit juices and ORS etc. Take fresh fruits & vegetables and adequate rest in case of symptoms of Dengue.


