landmines and a mortar shell exploded near the Line of Control (LoC) in Jammu and Kashmir's Poonch district without causing any harm to human lives, officials said on Thursday.

The mortar shell buried underground went off when an earth-mover was digging the land at Sagra village in Mankote area on Thursday morning, the officials said. The driver of the excavator escaped unhurt in the explosion that rocked the area.





Land belonging to Pakistan-based terrorist attached

RAMBAN: Agricultural land belonging to a Pakistan-based terrorist was attached in the Ramban district on Thursday, police said. The land measuring 4.11 kanals and located in Dumki-Sumber belongs to Faroog Ahmad alias Abid. It was attached under Section 25 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, a police

spokesperson said. Following due legal procedures, the property was recorded in official revenue records and a notice prohibiting sale or transfer was duly served, he said.

The attachment was executed in the presence of an execu-

tive magistrate and other official witnesses, ensuring compliance with legal norms, he added. "This decisive move marks a significant milestone in the ongoing investigation into unlawful and subversive activities in the region. "It underscores the police's

firm resolve and commitment to neutralise threats to national security and strengthen internal security in the Union Territory," the spokesperson said. In June, police had attached 1.11 kanals of land belonging to another Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK)-based terrorist, Ali Mohammed alias Ibrahim of Sumber village.
