- The particulars of the candidates verified and certified by the concerned Affiliated Academic Institution shall be recorded in the
- JKBOSE database as final and no further correspondence or claim, whatsoever shall be accepted at later stage on this score. Only those Academic Institutions who are affiliated with the JKBOSE and in whose favour the facilities for the current Academic Session 2024-25 WZ have been released by the General Section shall be able to transmit the registration returns of their on-roll eligible students of class 9th.
- The CWSN candidates having disability of (40) Forty percent or more are exempted from paying Registration Return fee. However they shall take a printout of the registration return form submitted online, get it attested by the head of the concerned Academi Institution and submit the same in the concerned Sub/branch offices of the JKBOSE along-with disability Certificate from the con cerned Medical Board.
