

JKTPO organises 4th Export Awareness cum E-Commerce On-boarding Drive in District Udhampur

UDHAMPUR: Continuing its 2025 series of Export Awareness Workshops, the Jammu and Kashmir Trade Promotion Organization (JKTPO), under the aegis of the Industries & Commerce Department, organized the 4th Export Awareness cum E-Commerce Onboarding Drive in District Udhampur on 10th October 2025.

The workshop was held with the Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT), District Administration Udhampur, Federation of Indian Export Organizations (FIEO), Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), HDFC Bank and the Government e-Marketplace (GeM).

The event aimed to sensitize and support MSMEs, artisans, entrepreneurs, and farmers about export potential, government incentives, and e-commerce integration.

Experts conducted interactive sessions on export benefits, IEC registration, India Business and Trade Portals, credit and risk insurance, logistics, and digital market access for local products.

Prem Singh, Additional DC, Udhampur inaugurated the workshop and emphasized the district's export potential under the ODOP-DEH initiative, highlighting products like Pickle, Tourism and Garlic. She underlined the importance of capacity building, quality enhancement and market-oriented skill development to strengthen Udhampur's export ecosystem.

The workshop witnessed

enthusiastic participation from around 130 participants, including local artisans, MSME representatives, entrepreneurs and farmers. With this, the series has so far seen strong participation -110 in Samba, 100 in Jammu and 90 in Kathua- reflecting the growing interest of local producers in exploring export opportunities and digital commerce integration.

Representatives from DGFT, APEDA, FIEO, HDFC Bank and GeM provided guidance on export opportunities and support. DGFT highlighted schemes like EPCG, MEIS, SEIS and Advance Authorization,

along with IEC registration. APEDA spoke on export standards, product registration and branding support, while FIEO promoted the India Business Portal for global visibility, credit support and trade updates. ECGC explained credit risk insurance protecting exporters from defaults and political risks and HDFC Bank outlined export finance, working capital solutions and digital banking tools. GeM demonstrated vendor onboarding, encouraging entrepreneurs to leverage the platform for nationwide exposure, transparent procurement and timely payments.

ii) Only those on-roll students of class 9th for the Academic Session 2024-25 WZ are eligible for the submission of Registration Returns who shall attain age of Fourteen (14) years plus on First day of November 2026 in case of winter zone areas of Jammu Division to appear in Secondary School Examination (Class 10th).
iii) The concerned Heads of the Affiliated Academic institutions shall verify and ensure that all the filled-in particulars are genuine and strictly in accordance to the Admission Records before forwarding these (online) to the JKBOSE.
iv) The particulars of the candidates verified and certified by the concerned Affiliated Academic Institution shall be recorded in the JKBOSE database as final and no further correspondence or claim, whatsoever shall be accepted at later stage on this score.
v) Only those Academic Institutions who are affiliated with the JKBOSE and in whose favour the facilities for the current Academic Session 2024-25 WZ have been released by the General Section shall be able to transmit the registration returns of their on-roll eligible students of class 9th.
vi) The CWSN candidates having disability of (40) Forty percent or more are exempted from paying Registration Return fee. However, they shall take a printout of the registration return form submitted online, get it attested by the head of the concerned Academic Institution and submit the same in the concerned Sub/branch offices of the JKBOSE along-with disability Certificate from the concerned Medical Board. The Concerned Board office shall verify the cases and forward the list of verified cases to the Registration section, Jammu.
