Two Udhampur men sentenced to life for 2015 double murder over land dispute

JAMMU: The Principal Sessions Judge Udhampur, Virender Singh Bhoul, on Tuesday sentenced two men, Kaka Ram of Sadota and Khem Raj of Basnoto, to rigorous imprisonment for life in connection with the 2015 double murder case. The convicts were found guilty of murdering Siraj Din and his son Binya in June 2015 following a bitter land dispute. According to the prosecution, the victims were attacked inside their house with axes after the accused trespassed with the common intention of eliminating them to settle scores over money and land ownership. The FIR was registered at Panchari Police Station after complainant Abdul Karim, brother of deceased Siraj Din, reported that his brother had purchased land from Kaka Ram three decades ago and was living there with his family. On June 23, 2015, both father and son were discovered killed with deep injuries on their head and neck. Police recovered blood-stained soil, weapons, and clothes, and witnesses testified to the recovery of axes used in the killings. Public Prosecutors Himanshu Parkash and Vinay Sharma pressed for maximum punishment, calling the crime brutal and motivated by greed. Appearing for the convicts, Advocate Ashutosh Gupta argued for leniency, citing their old age, family responsibilities, and lack of prior criminal record. The Court held that the murders were the result of "dishonest intention and greed for land" on the part of the convicts. While noting the heinousness of the crime, the judge ruled that it did not fall under the "rarest of rare" category warranting the death penalty. Instead, the convicts were sentenced to life imprisonment under Section 302 RPC with a fine of ₹10,000 each, and 10 years of rigorous imprisonment under Section 449 RPC with a fine of ₹5,000 each. The sentences will run concurrently. In case of default in payment, further imprisonment will follow. The Court ordered that the fine, if realized, be paid to the legal heirs of the deceased and recommended that the J&K State Legal Services Authority extend statutory compensation to the bereaved family. The judgment and sentence have been referred to the High Court of J&K and Ladakh for confirmation. The convicts have been informed of their right to appeal within 14 days.

HC seeks Govt objections in MLA Malik's plea to attend Assembly, vote in Rajya Sabha polls

JAMMU: The High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh on Tuesday took up fresh proceedings in the preventive detention case of Doda (East) MLA Mehraj Malik, who continues to remain under custody following his detention under the J&K Public Safety Act (PSA), 1978 on September 8, 2025, through Detention Order No. 05 of 2025 issued by the District Magistrate, Doda. At today's hearing before Justice Sanjay Dhar, Advocate Sheikh Shakeel Ahmed filed an application praying for interim relief. The application specifically sought directions to allow the sitting MLA to participate in the ongoing Assembly session and represent his constituency, and cast his vote in the forthcoming Rajya Sabha elections. It was argued that preventing Malik from discharging his functions as a legislator would not only violate his constitutional rights but also deprive the people of Doda East of effective representation in the legislature. On behalf of the Union Territory administration, Senior Advocate Sunil Sethi appeared and requested additional time to file objections to the fresh application. After hearing both sides, Justice Sanjay Dhar ordered the UT Government to submit its objections and directed that the application be listed again on Saturday. Justice Sanjay Dhar further clarified that the main Habeas Corpus petition-challenging Malik's PSA detention-will be heard on November 7, 2025, by which date the UT administration must file its detailed response. It may be recalled that on September 24, 2025, Justice Vinod Chatterji Koul had admitted Malik's habeas corpus plea and issued notices to the Principal Secretary (Home), District Magistrate Doda, SSP Doda, and Superintendent District Jail Kathua. These notices were accepted in court by Sr. AAG Monika Kohli, who was granted time to file the government's reply. The habeas corpus petition, filed by Malik challenges the very legality of the detention order. It alleges personal bias on the part of the District Magistrate and seeks not only the quashment of the PSA order but also Rs 5 crore in compensation for violation of personal liberty.

Safety Advisory for Cracker Stalls

1. The stalls shall be established in open spaces away from flammable materials. 2. A safe distance not less than 15 feet shall be maintained between two consecutive stalls and the gap shall be kept clear and free from any obstructions. 3. While erecting/constructing a stall, fire resistant material shall be used preferably Angle Iron/ GI sheets or asbestos sheets. No polythene or synthetic fibre should be used for cladding purposes. 4. Each stall shall have proper ventilation. 5. Proper packing and labelling of Fire Crackers with user instructions shall be ensured by the stall owners. 6. The fire crackers shall be stored in sealed and fire resistant containers and kept away from heat sources. 7. Each stall holder shall keep readily available the fire extinguishers and buckets filled with sand near the stall as per the recommendations of Fire and Emergency Services. 8. Every stall shall have emergency contact numbers 101, 100, 102, contact numbers of nearest fire station, police station and nearest hospital at display conspicuously. 9. Open flames, smoking, loose electric fitting is strictly prohibited in and around the Cracker Stalls. 10. The stall owners shall educate customers on safe cracker handling and shall provide safety guidelines and instructions to them. 11. The stall owners shall ensure proper and regular training and fire drills to its staff regarding cracker handling and storage, first aid fire safety and emergency response. 12. The bursting of fire crackers shall not be permitted in and around the fire cracker stall area. 13. The fire cracker stall owners shall strictly adopt and implement the fire safety guidelines and recommendations issued by Fire & Emergency services J&K.

Advisory for General Public for Winter Season

In view of rise in fire incidents, following advisory is issued to guide general masses to remain vigilant during the winter season & take following precautionary measures to prevent the fire incidents:- 1. Always ensure that all electrical heating gadgets are unplugged and Stoves, Bukharies, LPG Cooking Gas Stoves are switched off properly, before going to bed or leaving the room/ home. 2. Use Kangris with utmost care. Keep Kangris at safe places during nights to avoid its toppling. 3. Avoid storage of dry grass, rejection wood etc. in residential houses. Store this combustible material in isolated places away from residential houses. 4. Refrain from using faulty/ sub-standard electrical appliances, high wattage electrical room heaters, defective electrical blankets etc., which can result in short circuits and ultimately lead to fire incidents. 5. Use good quality fuses of correct rating, miniature circuit breakers (MCB) and earth leakage circuit breaker. 6. Keep the electric wire away from the hot and wet surfaces. 7. Stay in the kitchen while cooking. If you leave the kitchen even for a shorter period of time, turn off the stove. 8. Switch off the LPG cylinder and stove knob, when not in use. Proper ventilation should be ensured while using LPG Heaters. 9. Keep all escape routes and water access points clear, especially in residential and market areas. 10. Do not throw live cigarette butts carelessly. 11. In case of any fire incident, immediately call Fire & Emergency Services Toll Free No. 101, Control Room Srinagar Nos. 0194-2452155, 2452222, Control Room Jammu Nos. 0191-2457705, 2435283 or nearest Fire Station.
