

SSP Doda reviews security preparedness ahead of Diwali festival

DODA: Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Doda, Sandeep Mehta, convened a high-level crime and security review meeting at the District Police Office, Doda ahead of Festive season. The meeting was attended by all the senior police officers, including Addl. SP Hqrs, SDPOs Bhaderwah and Gandoh, DySPs Hqrs, DAR, and PC Doda, along with all SHOs and In-charges of Police Posts. SSP assessed the security preparedness of all the subdivisions of the district ahead of Diwali and it was stressed that deep deployments of police be made particularly in Bazaars and crowded places. A separate space be provided to the stalls for selling the crackers to avoid any mishap. Key issues discussed also included the execution of

arrest warrants under section 356(8) BNSS and the timely investigation of heinous crimes such as murder, attempt to murder, NDPS, UAPA, and POCSO-related offences. Clear timelines (60-90 days) shall be adopted for the completion of investigations and filing of chargesheets, with an emphasis on quality, accountability, and legal compliance. SSP Mehta directed the mandatory use of FSL services in all cases and the creation of a minimum of 08 SIDs per case, alongside uploading success stories under the new criminal laws on the designated portal. Officers were also instructed to execute summons and warrants electronically via beat incharges on the portal. A strong focus was placed on monitoring drug peddlers, OGWs, miscreants, and rumor-mongers. Preventive measures were stressed to maintain law and order and communal harmony, particu-

larly in view of upcoming religious events. Officers were also instructed to reach out to families of police martyrs ahead of Police Commemoration Day to offer support and solidarity. SSP Mehta called for intensified surveillance in higher reaches of the District to counter Anti-National Elements (ANEs), emphasizing the importance of actionable intelligence and disman-

ting support networks. In conclusion, SSP Mehta urged all officers to intensify their efforts for the peaceful conduct of the Diwali Festival. He also exhorted upon all the officers to remain alive to all the emerging situations and device strategies to counter it in anticipation, reaffirming the Doda Police's commitment to ensuring a safe and crime-free environment for the citizens of the district.

Subject: Advisory regarding Misuse of Courier Services for Trafficking of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) and Regulation thereof within District Kishtwar.

A D V I S O R Y

Whereas, pursuant to the decisions taken in the 14th UT-Level NCORD Meeting chaired by the Worthy Chief Secretary, Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir, the Home Department has issued directions requiring all District Magistrates to issue advisories to courier operators to prevent the misuse of courier networks for trafficking narcotic drugs and psychotropic substances; and

Whereas, instances have come to the notice of the authorities as well as the undersigned that certain courier services agencies are being misused by unscrupulous elements for the transportation and delivery of psychotropic and narcotic substances (NRX drugs), thereby posing a serious threat to public health, safety and maintenance of law & order; and

Whereas, it is imperative to ensure that all courier service agencies operating within District Kishtwar function strictly in accordance with the provisions of the *Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985*, the *Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940*, and other allied laws governing such operations;

Now, therefore, keeping in view the above and in the interest of public safety, all courier operators and service providers operating within the jurisdiction of District Kishtwar are hereby advised to ensure strict adherence to the following instructions: -


- Prohibition of Illegal Consignments:** No courier operator shall accept, carry, or deliver any parcel or consignment containing narcotic drugs, psychotropic substances, or any precursor material in contravention of the *NDPS Act*. Any such involvement shall invite strict legal action under the relevant provisions of law.
- Verification of Drug-Related Parcels:** Any parcel containing pharmaceutical preparations or drugs shall be cleared for dispatch or delivery only after proper scrutiny and verification by an Inspector from the Office of the Assistant Drug Controller, Kishtwar, or by the concerned Police authorities.
- Surveillance & Record Keeping:** All courier service providers shall install high-resolution CCTV cameras in their premises for surveillance and shall maintain computerised records of all consignments, containing full details of consignors and consignees for verification as and when required.
- Mandatory Registration:** All courier service agencies operating in District Kishtwar shall register themselves with the competent authority within seven (07) days from the issuance of this advisory, failing which their operations shall be liable to suspension as per the regulatory framework.
- Inspections & Monitoring:** The Police Department, in coordination with the Assistant Drug Controller, Kishtwar shall conduct regular inspections of courier offices to ensure adherence to these advisories and to detect any misuse of courier networks for trafficking activities.
- Periodic Feedback:** A fortnightly report on inspections and enforcement measures shall be submitted by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kishtwar, to the undersigned for onward submission to the higher authorities.

All courier agencies are **hereby strongly cautioned** that any direct or indirect involvement in the transportation, handling, or facilitation of narcotic or psychotropic substances shall be viewed with utmost seriousness and dealt with strictly under the provisions of the NDPS Act, 1985, and other allied laws in force.

Strict compliance with this Advisory is mandatory.
