Whereas District Magistrate Jammu vide the above quoted order has issued directions for the regulation of operation and movement of E-Rickshaws, E-Autos and E-Carts within Jammu District Whereas in pursuance of this order and for the information of general public as well as E-Rickshaws,

E-Autos and E-Carts operators, it hereby informed as under. 1. That all E-Rickshaws, E-Autos and E-Carts shall operate strictly within their allotted zones and inter-zonal movement shall not be permitted under any circumstances

2. That each vehicle shall display colour-coded identification plates and painted strips (front and rear) as per their assigned zones and Vehicles found plying without proper colour coding shall be seized and penalized accordingly.

That the operation of E-Rickshaws, E-Autos and E-Carts on Flyovers, National Highways and State Highways within District Jammu is strictly prohibited in the interest of public safety and for the smooth traffic flow. Whereas the following crossings on Highways have been approved for safe and controlled movement

of E-rickshaws, E-autos and E-carts between operational areas

Ambphalla Hospital crossing towards District Jail.

Bakshi Nagar crossing towards old Shakuntala Theatre. KC Theatre (Backside) crossing towards Shalamar Children Hospital.

Hotel Asia crossing towards District Police Line.

Shastri Nagar Cremation Ground crossing towards Shiksha Niketan School.

Marble Market crossing towards Greater Kailash. Kunjwani crossing towards Greater Kailash.

Whereasthe E-Rickshaws, E-Autos and E-Carts registered outside District Jammu are not permitted to operate within Jammu City limits and strict enforcement action shall be taken against the violators
