## CS for counselling to strengthen 'Nasha Mukt J&K Abhiyan'

SRINAGAR: Chief Secretary Atal Dulloo on Friday chaired a meeting to review the progress and impact of the 'Nasha Mukt J&K Abhiyan' an intensive anti-drug awareness campaign led by the Information Department across all districts of the Union Territory. The meeting was attended by the Director General of Police, senior secretaries from Home. Information, Social Welfare, Health, and Development Departments. Divisional Commissioners Directors of Information and School Education, and other senior officers. Deputy Commissioners participated through video conferencing.

The Chief Secretary empha sised the need for a sustained, community-driven awareness campaign involving Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs), Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), and schools across J&K. He stressed capacity building at the grassroots level and directed that counsellors be trained through IMHANS, including paramedical staff, teachers, and Self Help Group (SHG) members. These trained individuals, he said, would serve as counsellors in schools Primary Health Centres, and rural areas to effectively tackle substance abuse.

Dulloo directed Deputy Commissioners to identify suitable local resources in coordination with departments and asked the Health Department to design specialised training modules. He also suggested seeking support from NITI Aayog to ensure quality training and strengthen implementation. Additionally, he directed an audit of calls received on antidrug helplines to evaluate the nature of assistance offered to victims and their families.

Reviewing district-wise progress, he urged continuous rehabilitation and dignified reintegration of recovering individuals, providing them with self-employment and guidance opportunities.

Commissioner Secretary, Information Department, M. Raju, presented an overview of the campaign, launched on April 5 this year, aimed at making J&K drug-free. He informed that out of 7,847 planned activities, 6,985 have been completed, engaging nearly 3.5 lakh participants and sending over 1.11 lakh direct messages to the public. The campaign included 4,569 events in Panchayats, 556 in ULBs, and 1,860 in educational institutions Notably 117 individuals have been successfully rehabilitated through self-employment or higher education enrolment. Inspector General of Police (Crime) Sujit Singh briefed on police efforts, including the 1933 (MANAS) helpline and mobilisation of youth "Drug Yodhas," recognising 100 for their contributions.

Chief Secretary  $\operatorname{The}$ released the "Jammu & Kashmir Nasha Mukt compendium, Abhiyan" appreciating all stakeholders for their role in steering this vital campaign. He reiterated that collective, sustained efforts at every level are essential to safeguard J&K's vonth and ensure a drug-free future.

Whereas, the Directorate Youth Services & Sports, J&K vide order no. DGYSS/Estt/455-79 Dated: 09-04-2025, constituted District Level Committees headed by the concerned District Youth Services & Sports Officers and accordingly authorized these committees to prepare the District wise seniority of Physical Education Teachers as per rules in vogue and it was further ordered that the concerned Joint Directors Youth Services & Sports will examine the draft seniority lists and ensure that all the rules & regulations governing the formulation of seniority list are strictly adhered to. The final seniority lists shall be issued only after being vetted by the concerned Joint Directors YSS Jammu/Kashmir; and

Whereas, this office has already issued tentative seniority list of Physical Education Teachers vide notice no. DYSSO/R/ 906-911 Dated: - 07-05-2025 which was published in two leading newspapers for inviting objections, if any, from the stakeholders; and

Whereas, the aggrieved Physical Education Teachers submitted their objections in this office within stipulated time. During the scrutiny of the objections, it was observed by the Committees concerned that the issuance of appointment orders of many PETs were delayed due to different administrative reasons viz; receipt of CID verifications, Clarification of documents, court cases etc. which has disrupted the actual seniority position assigned to them in terms of Rule 24 of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956;

Whereas, the matter was deliberated upon at a meeting convened by the Directorate of Youth Services & Sports with both the Joint Directors and all the DYSSOs (and taking into consideration of various circulars and court judgements regarding formulation of seniority) it was observed that many Physical Education Teachers who figured higher in the selection list were appointed later and got placed in the tentative seniority lists below those who were lower in the merit

to them, creating an anomalous situation which may lead to avoidable litigation. In view of that, it was unanimously decided that the concerned DYSSOs shall submit the service particulars of those PETs whose appointment orders were elayed due to different administrative reasons for grant of notional effect of Date of Appointment; and

Whereas, a committee constituted vide DG-YSS/Estt/8276-87 Dated: 0409-2025 recommended the grant of notional effect to the aggrieved Physical **Education Teachers** 

Whereas, Directorate Youth Services & Sports J&K vide order no. DGYSS/Estt/10868-10928 Dated: - 20-10-2025 has granted notional effect of appointment to those PETs whose appointment orders were delayed due to different administrative reasons; and

In view of the above, issuance of tentative seniority list of Physical Education Teachers afresh is necessitated. Therefore, this office is once again issuing tentative seniority list of Physical Education Teachers of District Reasi annexed herewith for inviting objections from the stakeholders within 21 days in this office.
