BSP urges Omar Govt to promote employment through rural and urban industrialisation

JAMMU: The Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP), Jammu & Kashmir UT Unit, has called on the Omar Abdullah-led government to take immediate and concrete steps to generate employment through rural and urban

industrialisation. Speaking on the occa-BSPState President Darshan Rana stressed that the economic upliftment of both women and men is essential for building a selfreliant and balanced society. He emphasised the need to develop industries in both rural and urban areas to provide daily wage and regular employment opportunities, particularly for illiterate and semi-literate individuals who lack access to higher education.

Rana expressed concern that in many parts of Jammu, both youth and elders-male and femaleremain idle and unemployed, leading to financial hardship and social imbalance. He remarked: "For genuine progress, rural and urban industrialisation is a must. Unfortunately, nothing of that sort is being seen on the ground. The government must act swiftly to create real, employment avenues for the common people."

He added that the matter should not be politicised: "There should be Niti (policy), not Rajniti (politics). Employment is not a matter of politics-it is a matter of people's

dignity and survival.' The BSP urged the government to launch special employment schemes and industrial development programmes, focusing on skill training, small-scale industries, and cottage units that can absorb illiterate and semi-literate men and women in both rural and urban areas.

The party reaffirmed that economic empowerment of all sections of society, especially the poor, unemployed, and unskilled, is the foundation for a peaceful, progressive, and self-reliant Jammu & Kashmir.

Rana concluded emphasising that industrialisation and employment generation must become the top priority of the government to ensure dignity, stability, and sustainable development across $_{

revised in 2022, fixing it at ?9,330 per month. However, over the past three years, the value of

these wages has decreased by more than 40% due to the absence of a Variable Dearness Allowance (VDA), which is implemented elsewhere in the country to offset the rising cost of essential com-

modities. BMS highlighted that a committee, headed by the Commissioner, Labour

was constituted in 2016 to recommend VDA implementation, but no action has been taken by the government so far.

Other issues raised included exploitation of private-sector workers, such as the payment of single overtime in violation of the Factory Act, underreporting of employees in EPF and ESIC, and grave violations of the Contract Labour Act in various industries.

In response, BMS decided to hold a demonstra-Jammu in tion in November 2025 if the government does not initiate the process to revise mini-

mum wages immediately. Key participants in the meeting included Ashok Choudhary (Organising Secretary), Shamsher Chand (District President, Samba), Kuldeep Singh (Garden President, Contract

Workers Union), Mohan

(Office Secretary, BMS), and Yub Raj Singh (President, Distillery Workers Union), as stated in a press release issued by the BMS.

The meeting underlined the urgent need for government intervention to protect the rights and livelihoods of industrial workers and to ensure compliance with labour laws across the Union

Territory.
