## Stringent NDPS Act cannot eclipse right to speedy trial, grants bail: HC

JAMMU: The High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh has granted bail to Gurdev Singh, an under trial in a narcotics case, after spending nearly six years in custody, holding that the stringent provisions of the NDPS Act cannot be invoked to perpetually deny liberty.

Justice Rajesh Sekhri, while allowing Singh's bail plea, said that prolonged incarceration without conclusion of trial vio-

lates the fundamental right guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution.

Singh was arrested in December 2019 when Samba police intercepted his truck and recovered 370 kg of poppy straw concealed beneath apple boxes. Despite filing of the chargesheet, only nine out of 15 witnesses have been examined in four years, with the trial progressing at a slow pace.

The trial court had earlier rejected bail, relying on Section

479 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), which replaced Section 436-A of CrPC, holding that Singh had not completed half of the maximum sentence of 20 years.

The High Court, however, disagreed, observing that Singh had already spent more than six years in jail-beyond the minimum sentence of 10 years prescribed under the NDPS Act. "Prosecution cannot be allowed to invoke

Section 37 of the NDPS Act in perpetuity and dilute the fundamental right to speedy trial and personal liberty," the court noted.

Ordering his release, the bench directed Singh to furnish surety bonds of Rs 1 lakh each along with a personal bond of the same amount, subject to conditions including regular appearance before the trial court and not leaving jurisdiction without prior permission.

## Court upheld six months imprisonment in Cheque Bounce Case

JAMMU: Additional Sessions Judge, Jammu Ritesh Kumar Dubey has upheld the conviction of Rajesh Gupta, son of Yash Paul Gupta, resident of Rehari Chungi, confirming the sentence of six months' simple imprisonment along with a fine of Rs 4.65 lakh and 6% interest in a cheque bounce case.

The case was filed by M/s Gopal Concrete Poles, Kattal Batal (Nagrota) through its proprietor Krishan Gopal, who alleged that Gupta had issued a cheque of Rs 5 lakh dated December 4, 2006, which was dishonoured multiple times

due to insufficient funds. Despite service of legal notice, Gupta failed to clear the liability, leading to his prosecution under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Gupta contended that the cheque had been misused by his brother-in-law, a former bank manager; and was only given as a blank security cheque during a car loan process. However, the Court found the defence untenable, noting that bank records clearly showed the amount was credited to Gupta's account and subsequently withdrawn, proving enforceable liability.
