KPC urges J&K Admin not to force PM package employees to rejoin duties

JAMMU: Kashmiri Pandit Conference (KPC), in meeting held at New Delhi, while discussing various problems of PM package employees posted in Kashmir, urged administration of J&K Union Territory not to force PM package employees for rejoining their duties in Valley till a conducive atmosphere is established.
