

CS reviews progress of pollution abatement of Devika, Tawi in Udhampur town

JAMMU: The Chief Secretary, Dr. Arun Kumar Mehta on Friday chaired a meeting to review the progress of pollution abatement of River Devika and Tawi in Udhampur town under National River Conservation Plan.

Administrative Secretaries of Housing &UD, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, Deputy Commissioner, Udhampur, Chief Engineer, UEED and other senior officers participated in the meeting.

Giving details, Administrative Secretary, H&UD informed that Rs 186.74 crore project will benefit around 76041 souls in the district once it is completed.

He further informed that

construction of Ghats under package I of the project has been completed although there has been delay of five months.

Stating that there has been physical progress of only 39 % in the construction of sewerage network of 124.22 kilometres under the package II of the

project, the Chief Engineer, UEED informed that the project has been marred with significant delays despite the fact that the contractor has been penalised.

Divisional Commissioner informed that he had asked the departmental engineers to prepare activity delay chart and work out the penalty to be imposed as per the contract.

DC, Udhampur shared the resentment brewing in the residents of Udhampur town vis-à-vis the areas where the contractor has dug up the road sides for the project and have not refilled/restored them for a long time

Administrative Secretary, H&UD informed that the department for some time has been exploring alternative options for early completion of

the project and all steps necessary in this regard shall be taken.

He informed that the department has received a request from the contractor for engagement of subcontractors for the execution of the project and the same was under consideration within the terms of the contract while adding that the department shall not hesitate in taking stricter measures if necessary in public interest.

Stating that the execution of the project has to be expedited, the Chief Secretary directed the department to take all the measures necessary as per the contract to improve the pace of the execution.

Dr Mehta asked the department to penalise the contractor including in case he does not immediately improve the pace of the work at the site.

The Chief Secretary directed the DC, Udhampur to continuously monitor the progress of the project and also interact with the people in the district to address their concerns on the slow pace of the execution.

Navin briefs Union Secy on fisheries potential

JAMMU: Principal Secretary, Animal, Sheep Husbandry and Fisheries, Navin K Choudhary, on Friday called on Union Secretary Fisheries, Jatindra Nath Swain here.

Principal Secretary apprised the Union Secretary of huge potential of Fisheries sector in Jammu and Kashmir. He explained that Trout fish could become the next big exporting product of J&K after apples. In this regard, planning and preparations are being done to create a supply chain to help export local trout to various markets all over India, he added.

Navin Choudhary informed that 25 percent air freight subsidy is being provided to farmers and orchardists of J&K for carrying their products to other parts of India. He also informed that entrepreneurs are being motivated to set up plants for improved and sturdy packaging material locally.

He further revealed that the department helps in planting fish seed and the panchayats have been given the rights to harvest the produce and earn from it.

Principal Secretary sought support from the Union Secretary in perpetuating Recirculating Aquaculture System (RAS) in Jammu and Kashmir. He said that the same would further revolutionise the sector once robust power supply becomes available shortly.

Union Secretary expressed satisfaction over the progress of fisheries department in the UT and called for increasing local consumption as well as exports vigorously. He stressed on improved packaging, cold storage facilities and enhanced modes of logistics. He also assured support from experts of Central Institute of Fisheries Technology (CIFT) as and when required.

Director Fisheries, Bashir Ahmad Bhat besides other senior officers were also present on the occasion.
