KISHITWAR: Jammu and Kashmir Pradesh Congress Committee (JKPC), Vice President and Former Minister, G. M Saroori express deep grief and shock over the death of two young boys at Sinthan top of district Kishtwar.

Saroori prayed for peace to the departed souls and strength to the bereaved family to bear this irreparable loss and wished speedy recovery of other two persons who were rescued after being trapped in snow at Sinthan top area on Sunday. He conveyed his heartfelt condolences to the bereaved families at this hour of grief and prayed for peace to the departed souls.

He also demanded that the two who have been admitted to hospital where they are recovering from hypothermia be provided free specialized medical treatment and prayed for their early recovery. He further demanded sanctioning of ex-gratia relief to the kin of each of the deceased who were killed and urged Lieutenant Governor J&K for airlifting of dead bodies from Kokernag Srinagar to Kishtwar. Saroori further appreciated district administration Anatnag for launching the rescue operation during mid night thus saving the 2 innocent lives. It is to mention here that "A rescue team headed by SDM Kokernag, comprised of SDPO Kokernag, teams from 19RR, Police, SDRF, Revenue and other officials in extreme weather reached the spot where four people had been trapped in snow in Sinthan Pass. "Around 5 a.m on Sunday the rescuers reached the spot and started the rescue operation. One person had died on the spot while the other succumbed en route to the hospital.
