- Whereas, all the objections/representations were referred to the Committee of Experts as envisaged in Rule 12B of the J&K Public Service Commission (Conduct of Examination) Rules, 2005, as amended from time to time, For Independent Expert opinion; and
- Whereas, the independent team of Experts have recommended changes in the Provisional Official Key;

Now, therefore, in view of the above and on the basis of opinion of the independent team of Experts, it is hereby notified that:-
