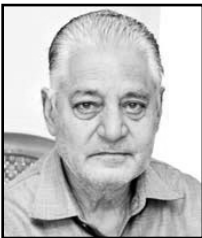

# CRIMEREPORT

## Gang of dacoits busted; 4 arrested, jewellery, other articles worth lakhs recovered

**PULWAMA:** Police on Wednesday busted a gang of dacoits by arresting four accused involved in extortion & theft cases. Jewellery and other articles worth lakhs were also recovered from their possession.

As per details, Police Station Rajpora Pulwama received information regarding roaming of a gang of dacoits in area during night time and extorting valuables on gun-point from innocent people. On receipt of the information, Pulwama Police established various check-points/ traps and nabbed one culprit red-handed at Hanjin Balla while executing criminal act. He was identified as Aamir Majeed Mir, son of Ab Majeed Mir, resident of Rajpora Pulwama. On search, one toy pistol & looted jewellery items were recovered from his possession.

During questioning, he disclosed that he along with other two persons namely Aamir Ali Chopan, son of Ali Mohd Chopan, resident of Rajpora and Umar Rasheed, son of Ab Rasheed Dar, resident of Rajpora were involved in recent theft and extortion incidents in Rajpora area. During further questioning, he also disclosed name of one goldsmith namely Altaf Ahmad Naikoo, son of Mohd Yousuf from Meemander Shopian who used to purchase stolen jewellery. All were arrested and shifted to Police Station where they remained in custody. Officers also recover extorted jewellery including 8 Golden Rings, a plain gold-en chain, a golden chain with beads, 2 golden pounds, 2 golden ear rings & a golden necklace besides a stolen load carrier bearing registration number JK03A-2171 from their possession. Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law were registered and further investigation started.

## 4,572.4 Kanals encroached land retrieved

**RAMBAN:** District Administration Ramban on Wednesday retrieved 4,498 Kanal Roshni and Government land in different parts of the district during a massive anti-encroachment drive conducted on the directions of Deputy Commissioner, Mussarat Islam.

According to Additional Deputy Commissioner Ramban, Harbans Lal, the land was retrieved by conducting a series of anti-encroachment drives by revenue department in past two days. The retrieved land included 80 Kanals in tehsil Ramsoo, 1,164 Kanals in Gool, 375 Kanals in Rajgarh, 922 Kanals in Banihal, 180 Kanals in Batote, 134 Kanals in Ukhral and 1,643 Kanals in Tehsil Ramban. The ADC further said that stringent action will be initiated against land grabbers under law. He informed that special teams were deputed to conduct on spot verification and eviction of encroachers from villages in all eight Tehsils of the district.

**DODA:** District administration Doda also retrieved 74.4 Kanals Govt Land in Kahara, Bhadarwah & Marmat during separate anti-encroachment drives conducted in these areas. At Tehsil Kahara, 15 kanals encroached government land, including 10 Kanals in village Malanoo (Khasra no 04) and 5 Kanals at village Batoli under (Khasra no. 23) was retrieved by revenue officials.

Another 24 Kanals and 5 Marla land under Khasra no. 178 was retrieved by the Naib Tehsildar of Tehsil Bhallessa, while 8 Kanals and 5 Marla Government land under Khasra no 323/85 was vacated in village Gutassa of Tehsil Bhadarwah and 4 Kanals and 10 Marla land under Khasra no. 489 and 5 Kanals & 14 marla Roshni land was retrieved by revenue department in Block Marmat.

## 5 bovines rescued, vehicle seized

**SAMBA :** Police on Wednesday foiled an attempt to smuggle bovines by rescuing 5 cattle and seized vehicle involved.

As per details, acting on reliable information regarding smuggling of bovines towards Valley, a party of Police Post Rakh Amb-Thali laid a vehicle-checking Naka near Kalibari,

Samba and signaled a Mahindra Pickup (JK08C-5255), coming via Border road and heading towards Samba, to stop. But, instead of stopping vehicle, the driver accelerated the vehicle and abandoned it few meters away from Naka. However, the driver managed to escape from spot taking advantage of darkness. During checking of vehicle, 5 cattle were found laden inside vehicle which were rescued. The vehicle used for transporting the bovines was seized on the spot and FIR No. 332/2021 under sections 188 of IPC, 11 of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Samba and investigation started.

## Two drug peddlers arrested; 380 Kg poppy straw recovered

**JAMMU:** Continuing drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police achieved major success by recovering 380 Kg poppy straw from two drug peddlers during a Naka checking near TCP Nagrota. The duo was coming in a vehicle (PB10 HH 6135). Police said that a Naka was laid by a team of Police Station Nagrota and SoG Jammu led by SHO Nagrota Insp Mohd Showkat. The police team intercepted two suspects and on their search, 380 Kg poppy straw was recovered.

The accused were identified as Talvinder Singh, son of Baldev Singh, resident of Dhalewal Chowk, Ludhiana and Jagdeep, son of Hans Raj, resident of Tajpur Ludhiana. The duo was arrested and FIR No. 430/2021 under sections 8/15/25 of NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Nagrota. The overall arrest and recovery was made under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Parupkar Singh and further investigation is going on.

## Narco smuggler arrested with 6.9 gm heroin

**UDHAMPUR:** Police on Wednesday arrested a narco-smuggler and recovered 6.9 gm heroin (Chitta) from his possession.

As per details, a party from Police Station Ramnagar led by Insp Kulbir Singh SHO Ramnagar under supervision of Anwar-ul-Haq Adl SP Udhampur, Dr Bhishim Dubey SDPO Ramnagar laid a Naka at Koutwa Naka, Ramnagar for checking of vehicles and apprehended a suspect who was roaming in a suspicious manner and trying to escape on seeing police party. However, police party caught him and during his search 6.9 gm heroin (Chitta) like substance was recovered from his possession. The accused was identified as Hamid Khan, son of Allah Rakha, resident of Shankar Nagar, Udhampur. He was arrested and a case under relevant sections of law was registered against him at Police Station Ramnagar.

## Lawyer among two found hanging

As per details, Karanveer Singh, son of Major Singh, resident of Adrad Mandi Mohalla, Gurba Slatiha was found hanging in his mother's house and was shifted to hospital by family members where doctors declared him as brought dead. The deceased was resident of Sidhra and had came to his mother's house from last two days.

Meanwhile, Mandeep Singh, a lawyer by profession, son of Rajwant Singh, resident of Bakshi Nagar was also found hanging in his house under suspicious circumstances. Police has registered both the cases for investigation.

## BSF Constable jumps into Chenab

## Forest fire along LoC triggers landmine blasts in Poonch
