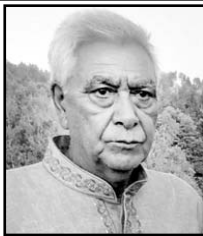

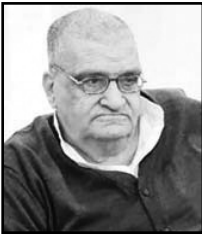

# CRIME REPORT

## 12-yr old boy dies due to alleged negligence of doctors at SMGS hospital; family protests

JAMMU: A 12 years old boy died due to alleged negligence of doctors at SMGS Hospital on Thursday night following which family staged protest.

As per the details, 12 years who was suffering from dengue died at SMGS hospital. After the death of child, family staged protest against doctors alleging death due to negligence of doctors. They said that the doctor on duty was not treating the child after which they requested him to do so but the doctor didn't attended the child. Irked over that, doctor called police which take child's uncle into custody. "Doctor started shouting at us and didn't attended the child despite repeated requests", father of the child stated adding that in the meantime child succumbed. " The doctor fled from the spot and police is supporting the doctor", parents alleged.

## Search launched in Krishna Ghati area as movement of suspects observed

POONCH: Security forces on Thursday launched search operations in Krishna

As per details, based on specific information about movement of suspected persons, a joint team of security forces on Thursday afternoon launched the searches in Krishna Ghati sector of Poonch district.

Sources said that no contact has been established so far but search teams have cordoned off the area. Counter-insurgency operation is already in progress for last more than one month in Bhatta Dhurian area on Rajouri-Poonch boundaries which started on October 11 after a fierce gunfight broke out between security forces and heavily armed terrorists. So far, nine Army personnel including two Junior Commissioned Officers have martyred in the encounters.

### Purse snatched from woman
