## Newborn's body found in garbage near GMC Rajouri

RAJOURI: The body of a newborn was found in a garbage dump near Government Medical College (GMC) in Rajouri district on Monday, officials said. The body was noticed by some pedestrians and the police were informed about it, they said. Principal of GMC, Rajouri Brij Mohan Gupta said that an inquiry is underway to ascertain whether any woman gave birth to a stillborn baby in hospital over past few days. "I have ascertained facts with concerned doctors and have come to know that three babies were delivered in hospital through cesarean on Sunday and all of them are in good health," he said.

"We are also checking records and CCTV footage of past two days," he added. Gupta said that a three-member committee has been formed to ascertain the age of deceased baby. He further said that Deputy Commissioner, Rajouri has also deputed a team led by a Tehsildar for holding an enquiry in the hospital.

## Over Rs 20,000 fine recovered for SoPs violations

RAMBAN: Continuing enforcement drive to implement COVID protocol across district Ramban, the Enforcement teams on Monday fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The enforcement teams, during the inspection in their respective jurisdictions, recovered a fine of Rs 20,800 Taking the total amount fined since April 1, 2021 to Rs. 61,98,050.

The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking COVID vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr Suresh informed that as many as 1,520 persons were administered first and second COVID vaccine doses across Ramban district.

As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, Dr. Mohammad Fareed Bhat, the Health Department has collected 1349 samples including 395 RT-PCR and 954 RAT samples besides administering COVID vaccine to 1,520 persons at dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.

## 2 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

SHOPIAN: Continuing its efforts to curb menace of drugs from the society, Police on Monday arrested 2 drug peddlers in Shopian and recovered contraband substance from their possession. Officers at a checkpoint established at Kanipora Shopian intercepted two persons identified as Waseem Ahmad Bati, son of Talib Hussain Bati and Muzamil Ahmad Janjua, son of Mohammad Amin Janjua, both residents of Saaj Thanamandi Rajouri. During checking, 10 Kg poppy straw was recovered from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 280/2021 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Shopian and further investigation has been initiated.

## 12 bovines rescued, smuggler held
