RAJOURI: Week-long celebrations of Jan Jatiya Gourav Saptah organised to commemorate the unsung tribal heroes, who sacrificed their lives for the freedom of country, culminated on Monday.

The Tribal Pride Week was celebrated under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav which is being observed across the country to commemorate 75 years of India's Independence.

It is for the first time that programmes were organised on such a large scale to pay tributes to tribal freedom fighters and celebrate the rich cultural heritage of the tribes.

District Administration Rajouri celebrated the Jan Jatiya Gourav Saptah with great ferv and held a series of activities at different places to educate the masses about the role of tribal leaders, including iconic tribal freedom fighter Birsa Munda.
